-CONSTITUTION OF SCARLET ARROW MEN'S HONORARY- (Continued)-

Article I:- Name: ~~SCARLET~~, each candidate will be known as  
The Name of this organization shall be the  
Scarlet Arrow.

Article II:- Membership:

Section I:- The active membership of this organi-  
zation shall not be more than fifteen regularly  
enrolled male students at any one time nor less  
than six regularly enrolled male students.

Section II:- Members shall belong to the Scarlet  
Arrow for life unless expelled for cause.

Section III:- Candidates must have completed at  
least six quarters and must have a cumulative  
scholastic average of at least 1.30.

Section IV:- The basis of selection shall be:

1. Outstanding service to the college.
2. Character, ~~and~~ ~~the~~ committee necessary to
3. Quality of leadership of the organization, and
4. Spirit of cooperation ~~as generally pertains~~
5. Scholarship.

Section V:- An eligibility list shall be prepared  
at least two weeks before election takes place  
and carefully considered by the members.

Section VI:- The members shall be chosen by secret  
ballot.

Section VII:- If the membership of Scarlet Arrow  
does not exceed twelve, each candidate must have  
a unanimous vote. If the membership exceeds

twelve, each candidate will be allowed one negative vote and still be admitted to the club. The Grandmaster or organization shall direct.

Section VIII:- New members may be chosen in the Fall, winter, or Spring quarters at the discretion of the club.

(1) The Scrapbook Chairman shall keep all items.

Article III:-Officers:

Section I:- The officers shall be elected at the last regular meeting in May and shall serve the term of one year. A quarter's membership shall be required before a member is eligible to hold office.

Section II:- The officers of this organization shall be:

(1) The Grandmaster shall call all meetings, preside thereat, appoint committees necessary to carry on the functions of the organization, and perform such other duties as generally pertain to that office.

(2) The Vice-Grandmaster shall perform the duties of the Grandmaster's office in case of the Grandmaster's absence, death, or disability.

Section III:- Notice of the amendment must be given one week previous to the meeting when the vote shall be taken.

Article VII:-

(3) The Scribe-Exchequer shall keep accurate minutes of all proceedings of the organization as the Grandmaster or organization shall direct; receive all moneys due to the organization, keep accurate account of same, and report them to the organization when directed.

(4) The Scrapbook Chairman shall keep all items of interest pertaining to the organization in a suitable manner.

Article IV:-Emblem:

Section I:- The emblem of this organization shall stand and appear to be a pin, which shall not be changed in any detail of color or design after its adoption.

Article V:-Fees:

Section I:- The initiation fee shall be \$10.00 which shall include the cost of the pin.

Section II:- Assessments may be levied to meet extra expenses of the club.

Article VI:-Amendments:

Section I:- This constitution may be amended by two-thirds vote of the members enrolled in college and present at any meeting.

Section II:- Notice of the amendment must be given one week previous to the meeting when the vote shall be taken.

Article VII:- Adoption of Constitution:

Section I:- This constitution shall be declared adopted on receiving a two-thirds vote of the charter members of the organization.

## BY-LAWS

Article I:-Honorary Members:Article II:-

Section I:- The requirements for selection as honorary members shall be the same as those stipulated in Article II for regular candidates.

Article III:-

Section II:- Candidates for honorary membership shall be selected by unanimous vote of the regular members only.

Section III:- Honorary members shall have the right to attend meetings and to speak, but not to make motions or to vote.

Section IV:- Honorary members shall belong to Scarlet Arrow for life unless expelled for cause.

Section V:- The wearing of the club emblem is optional for honorary members and no fees other than the cost of the pin, if desired, shall be levied against honorary members.
