Thisancourt Vages, Feb. 27, 1919

My dear Mother:

Nothing of importance has happened this week. I am just writing a word so that you will get something for the week. I am going to Nancy tomorrow and expect to go around by St. Die. This is a place I have long wanted to see.

I have to get up at 3 o'clock and walk to Mirécour to catch the 5 o'clock train. So I have borrowed Mr. Bastian's alarm clock to make sure of waking up.

I will drop this in the Poste Civile Boite tomorrow as I go by.
