STATE NORMAL SCHOOL CHENEY, WASH. OFFICE OF PRINCIPAL

Cheney, Washington, July 30, 13.

A Meeting of the Board of Trustees was called to order at 5:30 O'clock in the Principal's office at Cheney, Washington. The following members were present. Mrs. Monroe, Chairman, Mr. MacLean, Mr. Tustin, and Mr. Showalter.

The resignation of Miss Lexie Mead was presented verbally by Mr. Showalter at the special request of Miss Mead. It was formally accepted by the Trustees. Expressions of appreciation for the good and faithful work done by Miss Mead were expressed by the Board of Trustees, and it was unanimously agreed that the same should be conveyed to her by Mr. Showalter.

Om motion made by Mr. MacLean, Mr. Showalter was authorized to carefully investigate applicants for the Art Department and to, if possible, secure a teacher for \$1200. However, if a satisfactory applicant be found who cannot be secured for the above amount, the matter is to be referred to the Board of Trustees for final action.

The request of Mr. MacLean for leave of absence until September 15th was unanimously granted by the Board of Trustees. The regular monthly bills were examined and audited by the Auditing Committee.
