Cheney, Washington, Sept. 19, '13.

A meeting of the Board of Trustees of the State Normal School at Cheney was called for 3 O'clock Friday afternoon in the Principal's office. The special purpose of the meeting was to go over the plans of the new building with the Architect, Mr. Julius A. Zittel.

After the preliminary discussion, the plans were presented to the entire faculty. Some very minor suggestions were made, which the Architect felt could be easily arranged for in the plans.

The Trustees discussed at some length the financial situation, and a number of suggestions were made as to the best means of securing definite information from Olympia. It was finally decided that Mr. Stronach be instructed to issue vouchers for the land not yet paid for on the permanent improvement fund, and that he issue vouchers for the piano on this fund as well - thereby determining what action the State Auditor will take in these particular cases.

The regular monthly bills were audited, after which a temporary adjournment was decided upon until Tuesday, Sept. 23.

Those present were Mrs. Monroe, Chairman, Mr. Tustin, Mr. McLean, and Mr. Showalter.
