Spokane, October 25, '13.

A Meeting of the Board of Trustees was held in Mr. Zittel's office at 1:30 o'clock, Saturday, Oct. 25,'13, for the purpose of reading specifications and going over the plans for the last time. Those present were Mrs. Monroe, President Board of Trustees, Mr. Tustin, Mr. MacLean, Mr. Showalter and Mr. Zittel.

The specifications were presented and read by Mr. Zittel and, with the exceptions of a few corrections made, were accepted as presented. The Trustees authorized the regular legal notices to be posted calling for bids November the 29th, 1913, at the Principal's office, Cheney, Washington.

The question of moving the old brick bats was discussed at length, and it was the consensus of opinion of Mrs. Monroe, Mr. MacLean, (Mr. Tustin having an engagement asked to be excused at 5:30 and was not present at this time) that if this work could be done cheaper by employing local help it was to be handled in that way.

Mr. Showalter presented a plan whereby some of the citizens in the neighborhood of the Normal desired to put in a , and had asked that the Normal contribute \$100.00 to it as its part of the expense to be incurred. The general feeling of the Trustees was that this amount should be allowed for the work, if the sewer pipes be brought to the corner of the Normal School ground at the point where the Tennis Court joins the roadway.

Meeting adjourned at 6:00 o'clock.
