A meeting of the Board of Trustees was called to meet in Mr. Zittel's office at 4 o'clock to consider the question of bonds for the contractors, Bartlett & Roth, whose bid was the lowest on the Administration Building to be erected at Cheney.

It was reported by Mr. Bartlett that the bonding company had made unusual demands upon him because of the fact that a suit now pending in the Supreme Court relative to a contractor who failed at Tacoma has not yet been settled. It was reported that the Superior Court of Pierce County had made certain rulings, which seemed unreasonable to the bonding companies, and because of this they were taking undue precaution in this state until this matter is fully settled.

An extension of time until Wednesday, the 17th day of December, was given to Bartlett & Roth to secure the necessary bonds. It was urged, however, by the Trustees that in case Mr. Bartlett arrange the matter in advance they were to receive notices of the same so that they would be in a position to consider other contractors.

A number of vouchers were audited and signed by the President.

Those present were Mrs. Monroe, Chairman, Mr. MacLean, Mr. Zittel, and Mr. Showalter. Mr. Tustin was ill at home and could not be present at this meeting.

The meeting adjourned at 6 o'clock P. M.
