The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Trustees of the State Normal School at Cheney was held in the Principal's office beginning at 3:00 P.M. Those present were Mrs. Monroe, Chairman, Mr. MacLean, Mr. Tustin, Mr. Zittel and Mr. Showalter.


A report was read by the Architect, Mr. Zittel, on the contemplated change in the phone system. The plan, which was presented to the Board of Trustees, was approved. The changes suggested involved a saving of \$605 for the state. A copy of the same is herewith attached as part of the record.


Certain changes were recommended by the Architect relative to the plumbing and the same was approved by the Board of Trustees. No added expense was involved in the change. A copy of the same is herewith attached.

The Trustees recommended that before making any changes that Mr. Zittel submit the plan to the bonding companies for their approval and that any changes should be agreed to by the companies before the same are made a regular order of the architect.

The Trustees discussed the invitation received from Bellingham for a general meeting of all of the Trustees of the three normal schools together with the Principals and Secretaries, but no official action was taken. There was, however, a general approval of the plan, and Ellensburg seemed rather to be the choice for the meeting place.

The Trustees discussed in a general way the Faculty for next year, but official action was deferred until the next meeting. Meeting adjourned at 3:50 P.M.
