A Meeting of the Board of Trustees was called to meet in the office of Julius A. Zittel, in Spokane, for the purpose of considering bids for the Manual Training Shop. Those present Mrs. Monroe, Chairman, Mr. MacLean, Mr. Tustin, Mr. Zittel, and Mr. Showalter.

The eight bids received were opened in the presence of the contractor and were as follows:



John T. Huetter	\$14,950


The contract was awarded to the lowest bidder - Alloway and George.

A motion was made by Mr. MacLean and duly carried that Mr. Tustin and Mr. Zittel draw a suitable contract covering the work and submit the same to the Attorney General for his approval.

The Trustees examined the tentative plan for the dormitory, but took no action in the matter -----setting a time when they could give more careful consideration to the arrangement as a whole.
