STATE NORMAL SCHOOL N. D. SHOWALTER, PRESIDENT CHENEY, WASHINGTON

October 30, 1917.

A Meeting of the Board of Trustees was held at Davenport Hotel at 12:00. Those present Mrs. Mary A. Monroe, Chairman, Mr. McLean, Mr. Tustin and Mr. Showalter.

The regular bills of the month were audited.

Mr. Showalter presented the need of re-pointing the terra cotta on the main building with cement mortar and the Trustees authorized the work to be done. The Board also authorized some changes to be made in connection with the Manual Training Building which would make it more usable and adaptable to the work of the Department.

Mr. Showalter called the attention of the Board of Trustees to the report which the inspecting engineer, Mr. S. F. Roberts had made concerning the heating plant. He also gave them in substance the result of a personal interview which he had had with Mr. Roberts concerning the work of heating engineer, Mr. F. M. Frouty, and statements which Mr. Prouty had made to the inspecting engineer during his visit.

It was decided by the Board of Trustees to make an investigation concerning the matter, and if necessary to send an inspecting engineer to make a more complete examination of the condition of the plant.

The Board adjourned at 1:40 P.M.
