May 4, '18.

A Meeting of the Board of Trustees was called to meet at Davenport Hotel at 11:45 A. M. Those present Mrs. Monroe, Chairman, Mr. McLean, Mr. Tustin, and Mr. Showalter.

The special object of the Meeting was for the approval of the instructors and employees for the coming school year, beginning September First.

The present corps of teachers and all of the present employees were recommended by Mr. Showalter and unanimously elected by the Board of Trustees. In addition Mr. Frank H. Arnold of Spokane was elected to take charge of the Commercial Department of the school. It is understood, however, that Mr. Arnold will not begin his work until September First. Other arrangements will be made for the summer months. Mr. Arnold's salary was named at \$2,000.

For the Summer Session, Miss Bessie Graham was elected to take charge of the work in Miss Atkin's Department, and Miss Frances Wilson was elected to have charge of the work in Miss Steven's Department.

Mr. Showalter was requested to look up the financial condition and make a list of instructors showing their present salaries and the possibility of any increase that might be made.

Meeting adjourned at 3:00 P.M.
