April 3 1920

A meeting of the Board of Trustees, was held at Davenport Hotel beginning at 12:00 o'clock M. Those present Mrs. Mary A. Monroe, Mr. Tustin, Mr. McLean Mr. Showalter. The special object of the meeting was to consider at full Board Meeting (Mr. McLean having been absent during the previous meeting) the readjustment of the salaries for the remainder of the biennium. After the matter was presented by Mr. Showalter, the Trustees re-examined all of the salary proposals and approved the list which is herewith attached and becomes a part of the official minutes of this meeting.

Mr. Showalter was authorized to explain to Mr. Fertsch that his salary was adjusted on a monthly basis to extend to the end of the present school year only. This was done because Mr. Fertsch had previously expressed his desire to leave the institution for study at that time. The salary adjustments proposed for Mr. Merriman, Miss Reynolds, and Miss Barton are to begin at the time they return to the Institution,

A special consideration was given to the arrangement of the Music Department. The Board raised the question as to the general plan of work and Mr. McLean made objection to Mr. Cline being made head of the department during Miss Wylie's absence. Other members of the Board felt that it was necessary to complete the organization at once and insisted that Mr. Cline be nominated as head of the department of the new arrangement. The Trustees authorized Mr. Showalter to write Miss Wylie concerning this plan, it being tentatively agreed that her salary be made twenty-four hundred at the time she returns to the institution.

In authorizing the schedule of salaries, it was voted to put this into operation beginning April 1, 1920.
