
Dear Mr. Buchanan:

The electric wiring in Dormitory is arranged as follows:

All lights in entire building with the exception of the lights in toilet room, matron's apartments and the two attendants' rooms on first floor, and the night lights in halls, are controlled by one switch located in cabinet in hall next to door to matron's room. Then all toilet room lights, lights in matron's apartments, lights in attendants' rooms and night lights are controlled by one switch in this cabinet.

This is arranged so that all lights in the building with the exception of the rooms above enumerated can be turned out at one time. The lights in matron's apartments and in the attendants' rooms are also controlled by switches within these rooms so this will leave only the night lights and toilet room lights burning when all other lights are out.
