#### Spokane, Washington November 2, 1925

Meeting of Board of Trustees held at Spokane, Washington -- - convening at four o'clock.p. m. Those present Mrs. Mary A. Monroe, Chairman, Senator Myers, Mr. Lund and Mr. Showalter.

The final draft of the budget was presented with the added item of a training school building and grounds to be requested of the Legislature from the general fund amounting to \$260,000. The amount named is in accordance with the estimate made by Mr. Julius A. Zittel, architect. The budget was approved with the instruction to have Mr. H. N. Stronach send a copy to the Governor with letter of explanation.

The President explained to the Trustees that a request had come from a joint committee, appointed by the Seattle Chamber of Commerce and the Spokane Chamber, for a copy of our budget. It was explained that this Committee visited the Institution, made a careful examination of the needs, and requested the official copy of our financial budget.

By unanimous vote the President was authorized to furnish both the Seattle and the Spokane Chambers of Commerce with the document requested.
