The lowest bid for the General Contract was that of E. J. & F. G. Morin, of Spokane, their bid being \$18,387.00. The lowest bid on plumbing was that of Edward McCaffrey for the amount of \$1,779.00. McCaffrey was also the lowest bidder on the heating contract in the amount of \$1,406.00. The Electric Furnishing Co., of Spokane, was the lowest bidder for electric wiring in the amount of \$818.00. As the total of these bids was in excess of the legislative appropriation, the Board of Trustees authorized Architect Zittel to go over the plans with these lowest bidders with a view to making some cuts to bring the work within the appropriation.

It was then moved and seconded that the meeting adjourn until Thursday evening, September 1st, when Architect Zittel's report would be considered and if satisfactory bids awarded.
