## BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING

A meeting of the Board of Trustees was held in the office of Engineer W. L. Morgan, Hutton Building, Spokane, Washington, on Monday afternoon, May 16, 1932. Those present were Charles P. Lund and Richard Munter of the Board of Trustees, H. N. Stronach, secretary, Julius A. Zittel, architect, W. L. Morgan, engineer, and J. M. Clifton of Clifton and Applegate, contractors.

The purpose of the meeting was to make final arrangements for all additions, alterations and changes in the sewer plans and specifications as provided for at the time of the original bid. After a careful check-up, it was deemed advisable to add an additional unit to the central septic tank as recommended by the engineer in his revised plans. It was agreed that this additional unit would provide a margin of safety and could be installed at this time at a much lower cost than some time in the future.

To the original bid of \$5689.00 was added the sum of \$1065.00 to cover all additions, alterations and changes, and a contract was authorized prepared to be entered into between the contractor, Clifton and Applegate, and the Board of Trustees of the State Normal School at Cheney, Washington.

The meeting adjourned at 4:45 P.M.
