## MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The Board of Trustees met at Mr. Munter's office at five o'clock Tuesday, September 4th, 1934. Present: Richard S. Munter; Joel E. Ferris; James P. Dillard; H. N. Stronach and R. T. Hargreaves.

BUDGET: Mr. Hargreaves submitted a new form which the school had had printed for reporting the budget. This form carries three columns and makes it possible to carry out the wish of the Board, expressed at the meeting August 28th, to report the fifty per cent increase effective September 1st, 1934, as well as the statement for May 31, 1934, called for by the Department of Efficiency.

After careful consideration of the salary schedule for the next two years, and in line with the action of the other State Educational Institutions, it was the opinion of the Board that the salaries should be partly restored, as more fully set out in the attached schedule, to be made a part of the budget for the biennium 1935-37.


The revised recommendation restores approximately two-thirds of the cut made in the salaries April 1932 and asks for the following additional help: Instructors—Kindergarten-Primary teacher, \$1,800; Training School Teacher, \$2,000; Language Teacher, \$2,100; Summer School Teachers, \$2,000; and others—Secretary-Teacher, \$1,500; George Pullen, \$1,320.


HEATING SYSTEM: After further investigation, as instructed by the Board at the last meeting, Mr. Stronach reported in favor of the installation of a conduit system to replace the old heating lines, instead of a tunnel system. The report was accepted after some discussion and \$10,000 was placed in the budget to cover the cost of a new conduit system.

TRAINING SCHOOL: The Board, after considerable deliberation, voted to increase the request from the recommended \$210,000 to \$235,000 for a new training school building, and \$20,000 for equipment.
