MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The Board of Trustees met at the Davenport hotel for dinner at 6:15 Tuesday, September 15, 1936. Present: Mr. J. E. Ferris, R. S. Munter, J. P. Dillard, R. T. Hargreaves and H. N. Stronach.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

BUDGET: Mr. Hargreaves submitted a budget for salaries and wages providing for approximately 90% restoration of the salaries cut. Some salaries were restored in full and some less than 90%. The total amount approved by the board for the 1937-1939 biennium, \$394,926.00. The figure for operations for the 1937-1939 biennium, \$67,060.00.

CAPITAL OUTLAY: The Board approved the following items for capital outlay: Paving and curbing, \$6,000.00; addition to heating plant to care for the pumps and machinery, \$2,500.00; Library building and equipment, \$197,750.00; boilers and heating line, \$27,500.00. After a lengthy discussion it was voted to include a request of \$16,000.00 for the purchase of land.




