<u>Meetings</u>: The Board approved the absence of the President from the campus from February 16, 1945, to March 5, 1945, to attend the meetings in Chicago of the Association of American School Administrators and the American Association of Teachers Colleges. Legislation: The Board discussed informally various legislative acts, likely to come before the legislature, which will effect the colleges of education.
