In the absence of Mr. Anderson, chairman of the Board, Mrs. Laughbon presided.




Mr. Gonser moved that the S. G. Morin & son bid of \$45,985.00 on the veneering of the Fieldhouse and the U. S. Insulation bid of \$20,999.00 on the siding of the fourteen frame buildings be accepted. Mrs. Laughbon seconded the motion. President Freeman put the question and declared the motion carried.

The contracts were signed by Mrs. Laughbon and Mr. Gonser and Mr. Rasque was authorized to proceed with the activation of the contracts.
