July 25, 1912.

The Board of Trustees of the Cheney Normal School met in the office of C. P. Lund July 25, '12.

Present at the meeting: G. A. Fellows, C. P. Lund, N. D. Showalter, and Sec'y H. N. Stronach.

Miss Pitcher was elected to a position in the Training School at a salary of \$1,000 per year.

It was moved by Mr. Lund that Mr. Showalter be authorized to hire Miss Rena Holden for the coming year. Motion carried.

The Board approved the change in the system of teaching in the Training School as outlined by Prin. Showalter.

Mr. Stronach was authorized to take up the matter of the burned machinery with Mitchell, Lewis & Staver with the view of deferring payment for the same until such a date when the finances can be put in better shape.

The Board approved the proposition of getting a small clock - automatic - for the bells for the coming year with the idea of turning same in on a big one in the new building.

The canvass fire-escape slide as purchased by Mr. Stronach was approved.

Mr. Stronach was authorized to try to lease the Rowley Cottage to the Y. M. C. A. boys.

Meeting adjourned.
