## SAVAGES EXPECT IMPROVEMENT

One of the largest turnouts in recent years would seem to indicate that the Savages' football fortunes are on the rise after last year's 0-9 record, probably the worst in the college's history.

Not only did 17 lettermen return for the 1962 season, but in the 50 other candidates were a number of tested junior college transfers and several freshmen who seem ready to step right into college ball.

Early practice found many of the lettermen fighting, and fighting hard, to keep their positions.

At quarterback, three-year letterman Jack England, back after being out for a year, and one-year letterman Bob Clark, found a capable challenger for their position in junior Lee Grichuhin from Concord, Calif., who lettered at Mt. Diablo Junior College.

Veteran halfbacks Glen Crandal and Chuck Jungblom found a quartet of able backs competing for starting spots. They are Willie Jackson, a Kirkland freshman; Dave Ricketts, a 1956 second all-city guard from Spokane, just entering college after four years of service ball, and a pair of sophomores, Rich Robertson, Spokane, and Ken Ward, Manson.

Dave Davis, a senior three-year letterman and former all-Evergreen Conference fullback selection, seems to have the inside track to that position.

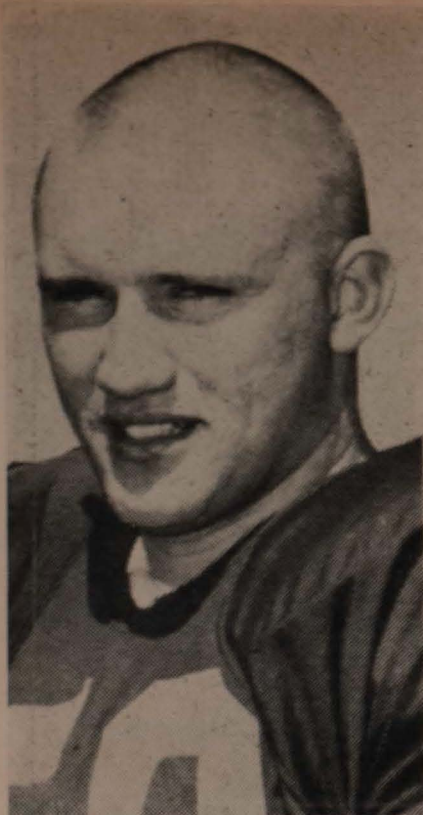
The Savages have five lettermen at end—Don Bade, Daryl Henjum, Mike Macaulay, Ed Thill and defensive whiz Paul Lerch, but Ted Paterson, a four-year basketball letterman playing his first college football, is also likely to gain a starting berth.

Three lettermen tackles, Dan Brown, Buzz Hatch and John Vick, find themselves challenged by a pair of hefty junior college transfers, 230-pounder Rich Jackson, and Bob Jundt, 210 pounds.

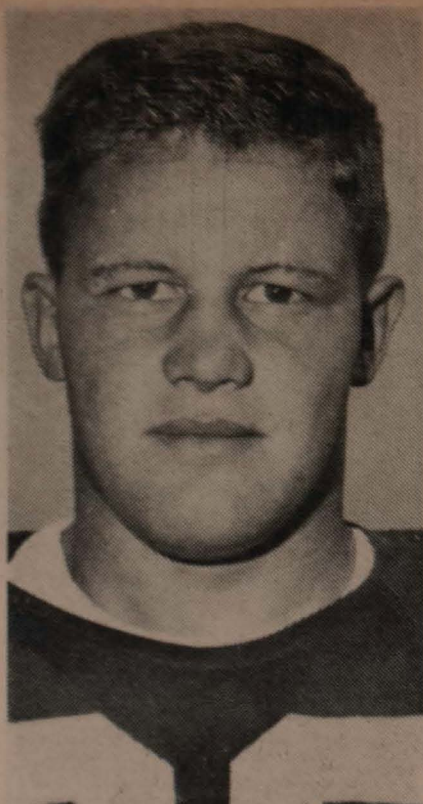
Mike Hess, Bob Miner and Keith Vradenburg are a trio of returning lettermen guards who will see plenty of action. Jerry Schelling returns at center, but 195-pound John Axtell is vying for the same spot.

With an increased coaching staff and with what looks like plenty of talent, head coach Ed Chissus has good reason for a bit of optimism this year.

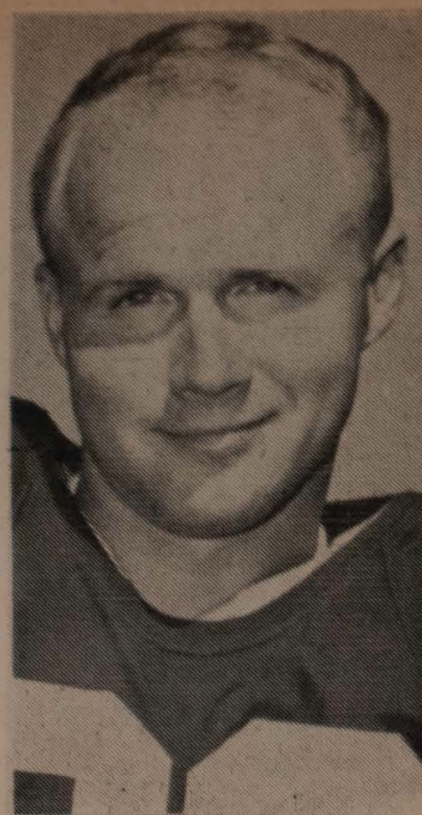




FRED VONAPPEN

## UNBEATEN STRING AT STAKE

Tonight Linfield will be risking two winning streaks. The Wildcats have a 10-game consecutive win streak on the Maxwell Field turf at stake. Linfield hasn't been beaten on Maxwell Field since 1959 when the Seattle Ramblers dropped the Wildcats 13-7. Another larger winning streak finds Linfield with 12 straight regular season wins. Last year's unbeaten Camellia Bowl club rolled through nine straight opponents, and combined with three straight victories from the tail-end of the 1960 season (last defeat was to Willamette 14-13) gives Linfield 12 straight triumphs.

Last year's club, ranked third in the nation and probably the greatest team ever assembled at Linfield, went on to play two post season games, beating Whittier, 18-7, and losing to Pittsburg State, 12-7, in the Camellia Bowl.

Tonight's opener with Eastern Washington State College will give Coach Paul Durham a good indication on how potent his new offensive backfield and defensive secondary will be in game conditions. Wingback Val Barnes, who broke Linfield's school record with nine TD passes last year, is the only member of the 1961 Northwest Conference champion backfield returning. Durham has the job of replacing a backfield that saw all four members ranked in the top ten in the nation last year in some statistical department. Getting the call tonight will be sophomore Pat Thurston at halfback and Dennis Vitale at fullback. Sophomore transfer Ken Scales is the pre-game choice to call the signals.

The starting offensive line is virtually the same as last year's undefeated club. The lone exception is sophomore Gary Walls, out all last year with a shoulder injury, who replaces All-American Jim Bernhardt at tackle.

On defense the Wildcats will be without the services of All-Conference tackle Pete Dengenis who suffered torn knee ligaments in the Varsity-Alumni game scrimmage. Durham plans to have Jim Sandsness open at offensive end and move to Dengenis' tackle spot on defense. Walls will also go "both ways" tonight. He will move into the middle linebacker spot on defense.

Tonight will be the fifth meeting between Eastern Washington and Linfield. Eastern Washington dumped Linfield in 1937 and '38 and the Wildcats came back to win a pair in 1951 and '52 from the Savages.

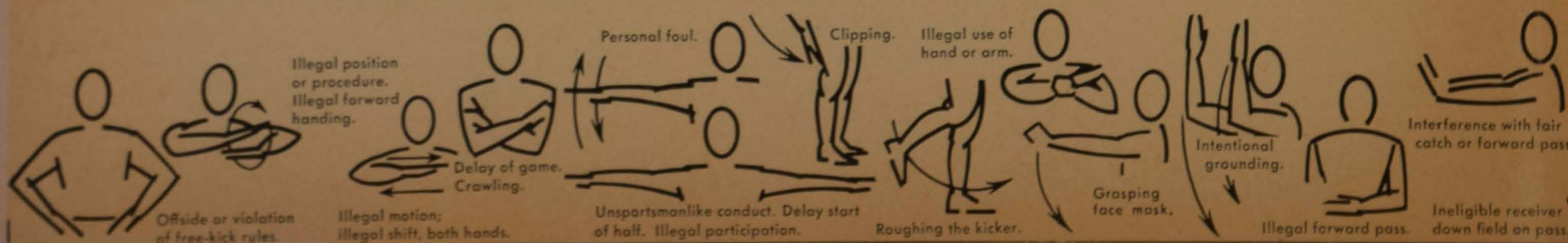

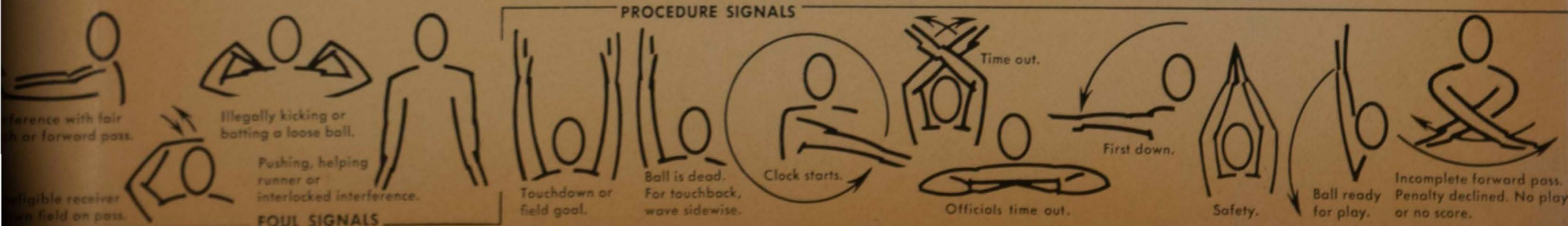
