



About Today's Game

Eastern's series with the College of Idaho goes back to 1925, but the two col-leges have played only 10 games, with C of I winning four, Eastern six. The most recent game between the two teams was in 1965 when Eastern downed the Coyotes 35-25 in Caldwell.

Today is Homecoming, and the Savages, though having good overall records in recent seasons, have not been able to give returning alumni a victory. It is hoped that today will be different.

The Savages are 5-0 this season, have gone 10 straight without a loss (but one tie), and are working and hoping for an undefeated season and a post-season bowl bid.

The Coyotes are 1-3 for the season, but have a better team than that record would indicate. C of I head coach Ed Bonaminio has 20 returning lettermen, evenly divided between offensive and defensive veterans and a number of outstanding freshmen,

Eastern comes into today's game off an outstanding 45-0 win over cross-county rival Whitworth College. The game should enhance Eastern's ranking in the Na-tional Association of Intercollegiate Athletics, where the Savages were 14th nationally before meeting the Whits,

Individual rankings of some of the Savages should also be raised. Quarterback Bill Diedrick was ranked 11th in passing in the country by the NAIA with an aver-age of 187 yards per game. This has now been raised to 193 yards. Diedrick was 15th in total offense with 194 yards before raising it to 209 with

the win over the Pirates.

Eastern's team average of 372 yards per game put the Savages 23rd nationally in the NAIA. The 580 yards gained against Whitworth has raised this to 413 yards per game and should elevate the Savages higher in this category.

per game and should elevate the Savages higher in this category. The Savages were ranked 12th in passing with a 218-yards-per-game average. Gaining 332 yards in the air against Whitworth has raised this to a 240-yard aver-age. Eastern's 172.6 yards rushing average is probably too low for national ranking. Ray Stookey is the Savages' top ground gainer, with 393 yards in five games for an average of 78.6. Pat Zlateff is next with 298 and 59.6. Dave Svendsen is tops in pass receiving, catching 25 for 426 yards and four touchdowns. Stookey leads the Eastern scoring with 48 points on eight touchdowns. Zlateff has 27 on four touchdowns, 10 conversions and a field goal. Roger Cramer has 24

Eastern's success this season-five wins in a row- is due to an attack balanced between passing and running-and to a stout defense.

Nowhere is Eastern's defense better than in its forward wall and at no time was the Savages' prowess better shown than last week when the defense held Whitworth scoreless.

In fact, the Pirates had only 92 yards net on the ground, and the much-publicized passing attack of Tim Hess and Whitworth gained only 120 yards in the air while the Savages threw for 332, ran for 248 for a season high of 580 yards gained in a single game.

Eastern's front four, while far from professional football's half ton or more, grosses 845 pounds, an average of 211 pounds each, just about tops in the Evergreen Conference and among other colleges Eastern plays.




The four starting from the left, are:
