Board of Trustees Minutes, May 6, 1913

May 6, 1913.

A special meeting of the Board of Trustees of the State Normal School at Cheney was called at Cheney in the afternoon of the above date. Present: Mrs. Monroe, Chairman of the Board, Mr. Tustin, Mr. MacLean, Mr. Zittel, Architect, and Mr. Showalter.


After going over the grounds carefully, the Trustees decided that the building should be brot forward about 18 feet near to the line of the concrete sidewalk in front of the old structure. The center of the new building is to be placed immediately in the center of the street known as Normal Avenue. This was made official by motion made by Mr. Tustin and seconded by Mr. MacLean, which was carried unanimously.


It was moved by Mr. Tustin and seconded by Mr. MacLean that the well should be tested, beginning the first of the week, and Mr. Showalter was authorized to arrange to have the work completed and secure the necessary material for carrying out the work properly.

A motion was made and carried unanimously that the city be requested to move the wooded main that passes thru the present site, because of the possible leakage which might cause the building to settle. There was also included in the same motion a proposition authorizing Mr. Showalter to have the spraying material taken out from the front lawn, and the grounds made ready for the raising of the old building.

Bids for the taking down and clearing of material, according to the plans and specifications on file in Mr. Zittel's office, were taken up and it was unanimously agreed by the Trustees that the work be awarded to Mr. Castello, who was the lowest bidder for this work. Mr. Zittel was authorized to notify Mr. Castello, and to exact from him a duplicate bond and contract for carrying out the work according to plans and specifications, and to perform the work within the time limitation as proposed in his bid.

Meeting adjourned at 7 o'clock P.M.
