May 24, '13.

The regular meeting of the month was called to order in the Principal's office at 3:30 o'clock P.M. Those present were Mrs. Monroe, Chairman, Mr. Tustin, Mr. Maclean, and Mr. Showalter.

It was decided by the Trustees to give Mr. Work a hearing since he had offered his resignation and gave as his reason a misunderstanding as to the management of his department. Mr. Work discussed at length his preparation and qualifications, and explained to the Trustees his viewpoint of Manual Training work.

Mr. Showalter explained that the real question was one of administration and not a question of Mr. Work's ability as a Manual Training instructor. The Board unanimously decided that the administrative viewpoint should be upheld and urged Mr. Work to accept this and continue his work in the Institution.

It was voted that the adjourned meeting be continued Wednesday, May 28th at Mr. Tustin's office in Spokane.
