Jim Northcott — A three-letter winner as a defensive back for the Savages, Northcott will work with Massengale and the Eastern secondary.



Gavin, Greg, C — Gavin returns for his final year to add to the honors already accumulated at EWSC. He was named the 1968 NAIA All-America second team; honorable mention, AP Little All-America; Little All-Northwest first team; NAIA district 1 first team.

Giampietri, Rick, LB — Giampietri transfered to Eastern last year from Grays Harbor Junior College and saw limited action at Eastern. He holds the North Central record for most yards in a single game, 225.

Jones, Carl, HB - Jones had an outstanding junior year and was selected for the Little All-Northwest first defensive team; a unanimous choice for the NAIA district 1 first defensive team and the Evergreen Conference first team.

Killoran, Merv, LB — Killoran is a returning letterman. He transferred to Eastern from Grays Harbor Com-munity College in 1968, where he was third in the conference in rushing and scoring and was an all-conference fullback.

Lee, James, T - Lee lettered at Eastern last year and gained that valu-able year of experience. In high school he was named district first team offensive tackle and defensive guard; Oregon State offensive tackle and defensive guard in th 1968 Oregon Shrine game.

Lundberg, Pete, E.-Lundberg won a letter last year and with two more years of eligibility shows great prom-ise. He holds the Wapato High record for touchdown pass receptions by an end; was named to the all-Mid Valley league and also won the inspirational award in basketball at Wapato.





THE EWSC ATHLETIC PROGRAM

Eastern is a member of the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics and of the Evergreen Conference, a league which welcomes Southern Oregon College to membership this year.

Other Evergreen members are the other two state colleges, Central and Western, and Spokane's Whitworth College.

The Savages compete in 10 intercollegiate sports in both the Evergreen Conference and in the NAIA.

In the fall, in addition to football, Eastern fields a cross country team. This year, for the first time, the Savages will compete in water polo, but on a club basis.

Winter sports include basketball, gymnastics, swimming and wrestling, and in the spring, Eastern competes in baseball, golf, tennis and track.

EASTERN FOOTBALL SINCE 1902

Eastern Washington State College's football history goes back to 1902, when the then Cheny Normal School played a five-game season, beating Davenport High School 53-0 and tying, 0-0, in a second game; losing 5-0 to Spokane High School but winning 12-0, in a second contest, and winding up the season with a 0-0 tie with Lewiston State Normal.

Cheney Normal School went on to seasons with as many as eight games, and with as few as two. Opponents were mostly high schools in Spokane, Davenport, Garfield, Colfax, Ritzville, Oakesdale and Coeur d'Alene, Idaho

Other opponents included such schools as Blair Business College, Spokane College and Spokane University, now long gone. After WW I, Washington State and Idaho frosh were opponents almost each season.

It was 1915 when Cheney Normal first met Whitworth College, splitting a pair in the first season of what has become Eastern's longest rivalry.

Five years of Cheney Normal Schools' early records, 1908 through 1912, are not recorded. The







fire of 1912, which destroyed the school's one building, also destroyed football records. And for three years during WW I, and three more during WWII, no football was played.

Cheney first met Ellensburg College in 1922 and the next year Bellingham College was added to the schedule. These schools are not Central Washington and Western Washington State Colleges, and Cheney Normal has become Eastern Washington State College. The rivalry among the three state colleges has continued since the first game, through two different conferences.

Now Eastern, Central and Western, along with Whitworth and newly added Southern Oregon, form the Evergreen Conference, competing in 10 different intercollegiate sports.

Through 1968, and without taking into consideration the records missing for five years, Eastern has won a total of 228 games, lost 175, and tied 16.
