Spokane, Wash., August 13, 1913.

A Meeting of the Board of Trustees was called to meet in Mr. Tustin's office at three o'clock P. M. by the chairman, Mrs. Mary A. Monroe. Those present: Mrs. Monroe, Mr. Tustin and Mr. Showalter.

The question of distribution of funds as arranged by the Legislature was thoroughly discussed and it was agreed that Mr. Tustin should take the matter up with Attorney General, by letter first; and if need be make a trip to Olympia with a view of adjusting the situation in the interest of the Normal School.

Miss Bertha R. Most was recommended for the Art Department during the coming year and the trustees confirmed her election at \$1200.00. Miss Most was notified by phone and Mr. Showalter was requested to send an official letter to her, stating the action of the Board and asking for her written acceptance.

Mrs. Monroe reported that Miss Wheelock had agreed to take charge of the work in the Primary Department in the Training School during Miss Barton's leave-of-absence, and Mr. Showalter was requested to notify Miss Barton, officially, that her requested leave-of-absence was granted. by the trustees.

Meeting adjourned at six P. M.
