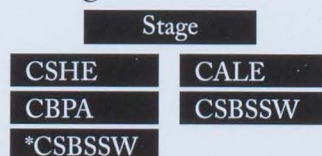

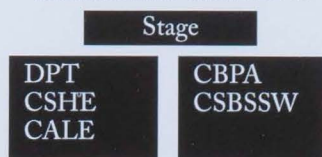
SEATING ARRANGEMENTS BY COLLEGE

A HISTORY OF EASTERN WASHINGTON UNIVERSITY

In 1882, the Benjamin P. Cheney Academy opened its doors to more than 200 enrolling students. A generous contribution of \$10,000 from a wealthy transportation industrialist had at last fulfilled the dreams of Cheney citizens for an institute of higher learning in their community.

The academy became the State Normal School at Cheney in 1889, the same year in which Washington was given its statehood. The school was proudly designated as an institution "for the purpose of instruction of persons, both male and female, in the art of teaching the various branches that pertain to a good common school."

By the time it became Eastern Washington College of Education in 1937, Eastern was already a fully accredited four-year degree-granting institution, offering majors in numerous subjects.

The campus grew rapidly in size and program offerings in the decades following World War II. In 1961, the name was again changed, this time to Eastern Washington State College. It was increasingly evident that the region needed professionals in many fields; in response, a wide range of undergraduate and graduate degree programs were added. Finally, in 1977, the name was changed to Eastern Washington University by the state legislature.

As a regional university, Eastern is charged with the special responsibility of meeting the undergraduate and graduate educational needs of the region's people.

To that end, program areas have grown and been redefined as the needs of the Inland Northwest have grown and changed. Master's programs have been added to meet the need for graduate-level education, and individual programs and schools have increasingly been granted accreditation by their respective oversight organizations as those programs and schools have grown and matured.

Today's Eastern students represent nearly every state in the union and more than 40 foreign countries. More than 100 different academic majors are available, offering students a wide variety of career-path options.

Nearly 600 full-time and adjunct faculty teach on the Cheney campus and at several locations throughout the state. Three-quarters of Eastern's full-time faculty members hold doctorate degrees. With a low student-to-faculty ratio, Eastern continues to stress small classes, personalized instruction and individual attention.

Perhaps even more significant than Eastern's steady advancement during the past 128 years is the university's expanded regional role and its evolving goals, objectives and vision of its future.

In the past decade, Eastern Washington University has become a major force in the state and the Pacific Northwest, not only in the education of more than 10,000 students a year, but in the civic, cultural, scientific and economic development of the state and region.

GRADUATION WITH ACADEMIC HONORS

Undergraduate students who have demonstrated exceptional academic performance are honored in the commencement program listing.

Summa Cum Laude: Seniors who have a cumulative grade point average of 3.90–4.00—Gold Honors Cord.

Magna Cum Laude: Seniors who have a grade point average of 3.70–3.89—Silver Honors Cord.

Cum Laude: Seniors who have a grade point average of 3.50–3.69—Red and White Honors Cord.

University Honors: Seniors who completed special course work requirements through the Honors Program—Purple Honors Cord.

UNIVERSITY MACE

The tradition of a ceremonial mace for academic institutions goes back to medieval times. Adapted in form from the ancient battle weapon used by knights, the ceremonial mace symbolized the authority of regal personages, city or shire ruling bodies and chief officers of chartered institutions.

Originally representing vested authority during all official meetings, it eventually came to be connected mainly with formal ceremonies. In academic institutions, this is usually in conjunction with an academic procession, where the mace is carried at the head of the line of march or just before the platform party.

The form of the ceremonial mace has remained fairly consistent over the centuries. Design often reflects the period of creation, especially in the elaboration of ornamentation. Gold, silver and dark wood are traditional materials.

Eastern's mace, commissioned as a gift during the centennial year to the university by former and present members of the EWU Board of Trustees, was created by artist-craftsman Clifford Gaynard after a regionwide design competition. Its planished silver head in flowing cuplike form carries the university seal. The dark rosewood shaft with upper and medial gold-plated bosses is gently curved into the terminal silver cap at the bottom.

Although the modern design departs from the traditional straight and elaborately ornamented pattern, it retains a full effect of balance, dignity and decorum, while capturing the flowing lines typical of the eastern Washington landscape.

A permanent display case for the Eastern Washington University mace is located in the Office of the President.

ACADEMIC REGALIA

The regalia worn for formal academic ceremonies such as commencements are patterned after the gowns and hoods worn regularly in the Middle Ages by scholars for warmth in unheated buildings and as distinguishing dress denoting their place in society.

A great variety of designs and colors developed over the years in the costume worn in different universities, but since 1895 in the United States, a uniform intercollegiate code of style and colors has been adhered to by most institutions.

In accordance with this code, most academic gowns are black, although some universities permit other solid colors. Occasionally, the robe color may indicate a professional distinction, such as deep purple for law or scarlet for ecclesiastical honors. Adaptations of the academic costume for high schools have sometimes used colors other than black for purely decorative purposes. Sometimes a distinguishing device on the robe or cap indicates an individual honor or a special occasion.

The baccalaureate gown is of simple cut with full, somewhat pointed sleeves. The front is closed and often no hood is worn with this gown. The mortar board head covering originated in ancient Greece, symbolizing the

commitment of the scholar to a life of building. It has either a plain black tassel or one of a color indicating the subject area of the degree. The custom of shifting the cap's tassel from right to left at the time of awarding the degree is used in lieu of investing each candidate with the bachelor's hood.

The master's gown is similar to the bachelor's gown, except that the sleeves are fuller, cut square with a half-circle at the bottom and sometimes worn with the arms through a horizontal slit at elbow level.

The doctoral robe is ampler in cut with a full bell-shaped sleeve, velvet panel edging in the front and three velvet stripes on each sleeve. The velvet trim may be black or in the color appropriate to the degree. The mortar board tassel for the doctorate is gold. Some American and many foreign universities use cap forms other than the mortar board, ranging from a soft velvet beret to more elaborate fringed styles, each of which has its own historical tradition.

Hoods worn over the gowns have a velvet edging, usually in a color indicating the specific degree and a lining which is partially turned out to show the colors of the college or university which granted the degree.

COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER BACCALAUREATE



Dr. Mimi Marinucci

Mimi Marinucci recently received the Eastern Washington University President's Award. She also received a Professor of the Year award, as well as Faculty Merit Awards for Scholarship, Teaching and Service.

After joining the EWU faculty in 2000, as an assistant professor with a joint position split equally between the Philosophy Program and the Women's & Gender Studies Program, Marinucci was granted tenure and promoted to associate professor in 2006. She is currently up for promotion to full professor.

Marinucci earned a PhD in philosophy and completed a graduate certificate in women's studies from Temple University in 2001. She earned a BA from the University of Delaware in 1989, with majors in both philosophy and sociology.

Her teaching and research are focused on the intersection of feminism and philosophy, particularly as represented in popular culture. She is especially interested in popular culture as a medium for the production and dissemination of knowledge about who we are as women and men.

This past fall, Marinucci published her first book, *Feminism is Queer: The Intimate Connection Between Queer and Feminist Theory* (London: Zed Books, 2010). Also during the 2010-2011 academic year, Marinucci published the article *Knowledge as*

Kennenlernen: Subjectivity, Pluralism, and Intimacy, in the academic journal, *Social Epistemology*, and she published chapters in a number of volumes on philosophy and popular culture. These include *There's Something Queer About The Onion*, in *The Onion and Philosophy* (Open Court, 2010); *What's Wrong with Porn?* in *Porn – Philosophy for Everyone: How to Think with Kink* (Wiley-Blackwell, 2010); and *You Can't Front on Facebook*, in *Facebook and Philosophy: What's on Your Mind?* (Open Court, 2010). In the past, she has published articles on other aspects of popular culture, including, for example, *Buffy the Vampire Slayer* and *The Brady Bunch*.

Marinucci is also the founding editor of *Wave 2.5*, which was nominated for Utne Independent Press Awards in 2005 and 2009, in the "zines" category. Zines are independent magazines, usually assembled and distributed by hand. In addition to making her own zine, Marinucci has given a number of workshops and presentations on zine-making as an alternative to mainstream publishing. She also encourages her students to create or contribute to zines as a means of expressing their own ideas, especially when these ideas are ignored or misrepresented by established sources.

Marinucci is deeply committed to teaching and mentoring students. Not only has she developed several new courses, including interdisciplinary

courses cross-listed between philosophy and women's & gender studies, but she also regularly works with students to develop their original research for presentation at local and national conferences including, for example, EWU's Student Research and Creative Works Symposium and the National Conferences on Undergraduate Research.

Past students have recognized Marinucci for her support. She was selected to receive Eastern Washington University Lavender Graduation Ally Awards in 2010 and 2011, for supporting LGBTQ students. She was also recognized as a Jeffers Chertok Scholarship Faculty Mentor in spring 2009.

For the past 15 years, Marinucci has been an active member of the American Association of Philosophy Teachers (AAPT), an organization committed to enhancing and improving the teaching of philosophy in all forms and at all levels. She has been elected as an AAPT Board Member-at-Large, she has served as program chair for the AAPT Biennial Workshop-conference on Teaching Philosophy, and she has organized and presented various workshops on presentations for the organization.

During her decade of service at EWU, Marinucci has established a strong commitment to scholarship, teaching and service.

COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER GRADUATE

Amanda Reedy came to Eastern Washington University in 2010, as an assistant professor in the School of Social Work.

Prior to moving to the state of Washington, Reedy lived in Iowa. She graduated in May 2010, from the University of Iowa with a PhD in social work. Her dissertation was titled, Adolescent co-occurring disorders: Factors related to mental health problems among substance using adolescents.

Reedy earned a Master of Social Work (MSW) degree from the University of Iowa in 2005, as well as bachelor degrees in psychology and speech pathology, also from the University of Iowa.

Following her graduation from the University of Iowa's MSW program, she worked as a case manager for a federally-funded project, where she evaluated adolescents for substance use problems, provided them strengths-oriented feedback and made treatment recommendations. Reedy has also worked as a counselor for adults with substance use problems at a community agency in Iowa. As a counselor, she evaluated adults in jail for substance use problems, diagnosed substance use disorders and recommended treatment.

At EWU, she has taught in two main content areas. The first area is focused on practice courses. These are courses where MSW students develop the skills

needed to engage in effective practice with clients. These courses have included the course assessment and practice with individuals and families and the course intervention and evaluation with individuals and families. Reedy also teaches the research courses for the MSW students. These courses include a class focused on locating and evaluating empirical literature using the Evidence Based Practice Process and a course on program evaluation.

Reedy has developed a new course that she will be teaching this summer, Social Work with Military Veterans and Families. Her interest in veterans and military families developed due to her husband's service in the Iowa Army National Guard. Her husband served in Afghanistan from 2004-05.

She also chairs oral examinations for students graduating with the MSW degree and guides them through the process – from writing the competency statement to the oral exam. Reedy is on the School of Social Work Graduate Committee and is involved with the EWU Military Student Affairs Committee and the Spokane area Operation Military Kids.

Reedy has several publications with colleagues in scholarly journals. These articles include "Iowa Case Management for Rural Drug Abuse," in *Research on Social Work Practice*, "Treatment Issues with Substance Use Disorder Clients Who Have Mood or

Anxiety Disorders," in *Mental Health and Substance Use: Dual Diagnosis*, and "Comprehensive Case Management for Substance Use Disorder Clients Who Have Mood or Anxiety Disorders," in *Mental Health and Substance Use: Dual Diagnosis*. She has contributed to a report for the Iowa Chapter of the National Association for Social Workers. She also contributed to a monograph on case management and drug courts.

In October 2011, Reedy will be presenting on the topic of measuring and assessing for mental health problems. The title of the presentation is "The Unequal Divide: Measuring Disorders Dichotomously and on a Continuum." She has presented several times at the national annual program meeting for the Council on Social Work Education.

Reedy has been awarded fellowships for the development and presentation of her research. Most recently, she was awarded the Eastern Washington University Faculty Research Grant. This grant will fund her summer research on military families. The purpose of the proposed research is to understand the formal and informal supports that military families are accessing and the families' satisfaction with those resources. She hopes that the results of that research will contribute to improving access to and sources of assistance for military families and lead

Douglas D. Bickerstaff

Douglas D. Bickerstaff, BA, MS, PhD, MS, joined the Eastern Washington University Computer Science Department in fall 1986. He eagerly accepted the challenge to develop both high-quality software engineering and database management systems curricula. His degree of success in realizing those goals, over a quarter century, can be quantitatively measured by the number of courses created, software grants, internships and masters projects directed and the number of team projects successfully developed for "real world" clients.

While Bickerstaff acknowledges the validity of such quantitative measures, he prefers a qualitative sanity check measure in the form of unsolicited email from former students. This recent message is indicative of Bickerstaff's unwavering commitment to the original goals that led him to Eastern. "I look back with great fondness on the software engineering courses I took from you, and offer my humble gratitude for the rigor and general seriousness you made part of your daily lessons," wrote a former student.

Bickerstaff's dedication to faculty and industry collaboration were manifested in NORCUS Fellowships in computerized adaptive testing research with the computer-based training department at Westinghouse Hanford, and in his role as faculty coordinator of the computer assisted instruction component of a five-year Title III grant.

His computing expertise naturally led to university and community service in the form of leadership roles on the Academic Computing Council and Inland Northwest Association of Computing Machinery.

Bickerstaff's commitment, dedication and expertise are clear reflections of his pursuit of lifelong learning. With fond memories of EWU students intact, he eagerly anticipates new challenging opportunities in retirement.



Marilyn Carpenter

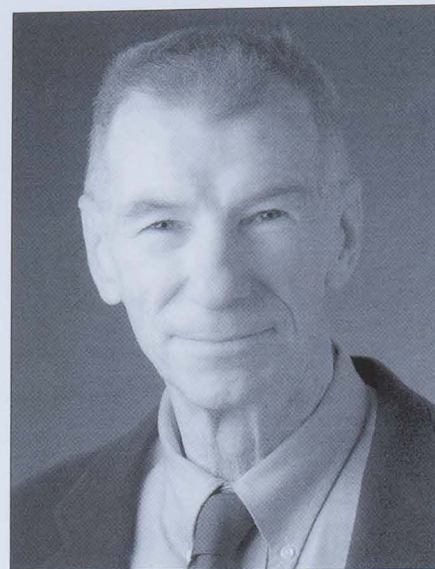
Marilyn Carpenter joined the faculty at Eastern Washington University in the Education Department in January 1998. She has taught classes in the reading major concentrating on children's and teen literature as well as literacy courses. She received her doctorate degree from the University of Arizona. Her passion is reading and sharing the review copies of children and young adult books she receives from major publishers. Those books have been available for students to borrow and share in their classrooms.

In 2008, Carpenter was recognized by the university with a Merit in Teaching award and in 2009, was chosen as Graduate Faculty of the Year. She has published more than 100 articles in national and state journals about books for children and teens and is a popular presenter at national and state conferences for teachers. Currently, she is serving on the United States Board on Books for Young People International Committee and is a judge for Best Books for Kids with Page Ahead. Her blog, The Children's Book Compass (marilyncarpenter.wordpress.com) reviews new books for children and teens. As a staff developer, Carpenter has worked for 20 years with school districts across the United States.

Carpenter's past experiences also include: community college instructor, elementary teacher in the Los Angeles City Schools, Title I Coordinator and Los Angeles Times book reviewer.



John P. Cogley

Dr. John Cogley's career at Eastern Washington University began in 1978. During the ensuing years he has served the university with humor and compassion, as program director and chair. Cogley has dedicated his career to the directorship of the Therapeutic Recreation Program, teaching, advising students and consulting with community and private agencies. In 1986, he was promoted to full professor and most recently has held the position of interim chair and chair of the Physical Education, Health and Recreation Department.

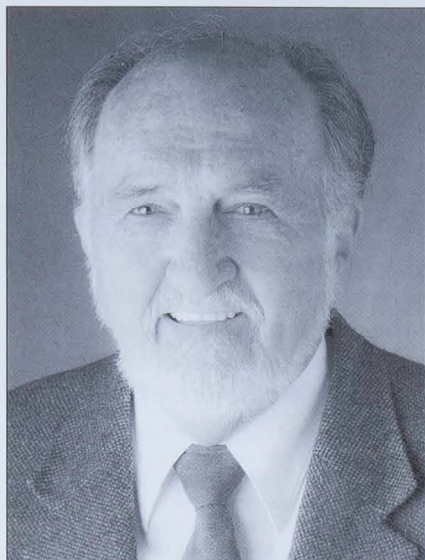
Cogley came to EWU from the University of Nebraska, where he was an assistant professor. From 1975-77, he was the coordinator of the graduate program in Therapeutic Recreation and Adaptive Physical Education at the University of Northern Colorado.

Under his leadership, the therapeutic recreation degree was accredited in 1990, through the National Recreation and Parks Association. From 1992-97, Cogley was a member of the Exam Development Committee for the National Council for Therapeutic Recreation Certification. Through his guidance, the American Therapeutic Recreation Association awarded Eastern's Therapeutic Recreation Program with the 2004 Excellence in Education Award. In 2008, he received an award for the "outstanding professional" by the Washington State Therapeutic Recreation Association.

He served as the coordinator of Disabled Student Services at EWU from 1984-85, and has been involved with Washington State Special Olympics, as a coach and winter games coordinator.

Cogley has touched the lives of numerous students, faculty, staff and administrators during his years of service to EWU. He and his family have been involved members of the community as well. Most recently, he and his wife Pat were the driving force toward the establishment of the newly created "Reid Meditation Garden," located on the EWU campus. This was a project designed to pay tribute to the wonderful partnership between the university community, faculty and families who were part of the Reid Lab School for 50 years. For those closest to Cogley, it could be said that he is never at a loss for words or phrases that are memorable.

FACULTY EMERITI RECOGNITION



Ernest H. Gilmour

Dr. Ernest H. Gilmour came to EWU in 1967, to teach paleontology in the Department of Geography and Geology. Previously, he worked as a geologist with the state of California, Cominco Inc., U. S. Geological Survey, and the Montana Bureau of Mines and Geology at Montana Tech. He has a BS from the University of Southern California and an MS and PhD from the University of Montana.

Gilmour participated in the formation of the separate Department of Geology in 1969. He served the university as department chair from 1976-1987, and from 2001-2008. Gilmour also served as graduate dean and director of research from 1987-1989, and senior vice president and provost from 1989-1991.

He was the first recipient of the university's Trustees Medal in 1978, and was named Inland Empire AIME Engineer of the Year in 1974; Northwest Federation of Mineralogical Societies Honorary Award in 1981; elected Life Member in Northwest Mining Association in 1988, and received the President's Award in 1996; International Educator of Year in 1990; elected Rock Rollers Life Member in 1993; and elected vice president of the All Russia and International Bryozoology Meetings in 1994.

Gilmour was selected as a Fulbright Lecturer and Scholar at Peshawar University in Pakistan from 1980-1981. He is the only EWU faculty member to be selected by the U. S. Academy of Sciences exchange program as an exchange scientist to conduct research and lecture in Russia (1974) and Poland (1975).

During Gilmour's 44 years at EWU, he has received 70 grants totaling nearly \$2.2 million to support students and his research on fossil bryozoans. He has hosted numerous international scholars and students in his paleontological laboratory.

He has been active in professional organizations by serving as president, secretary and treasurer and he served nine years on the national board of directors of Sigma Xi, The National Science Honorary Society, and 44 years as an officer in the local EWU Sigma Xi Chapter.

Gilmour has authored or co-authored 96 published papers and abstracts, mostly on carboniferous and Permian fossil bryozoans. Many of these papers are co-authored with former students.



Robert L. McGinty

Dr. Robert L. McGinty came to Eastern Washington University in 1980, and accepted a full-time position in 1981. He retired in 2010, after a 30-year teaching career in the College of Business and Public Administration. His areas of study and teaching include strategic planning, organizational behavior, management, human resources, economics and finance.

McGinty received his PhD from the University of Denver and his MS in business administration from University of Idaho.

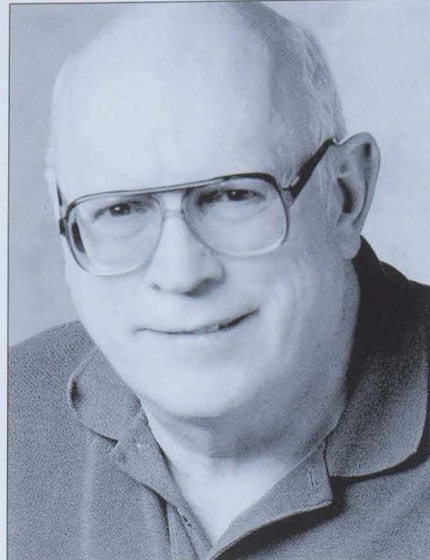
He was a National Science Foundation recipient in economics and participated in the development of input-output analysis at Lehigh University in Pennsylvania. He is a member of numerous professional associations.

McGinty has published and presented internationally, nationally and regionally. One of his areas of study has been the progress of women in business, and he was invited to present the highlights of his studies at a public lecture to the City of Nishinomiya, Japan.

He has consulted and published nationally and regionally on ski area strategic planning and implementation, including Colorado's Crested Butte Ski Area and recently, the five major Inland Northwest ski areas.

He has served on numerous committees including: General Education Review Committee, Athletic Policy Board, Teaching and Learning Committee, Internship Coordinator from 1982-2010, Labor and Management Committees, Faculty Compensation Committee, Chair of MBA Committee, College and Department Personnel Committees and faculty advisor of Team Red and Student HRM Association. He is a charter member of the Eagle Athletic Association.

McGinty has supervised more than 3,000 student internships. He developed the senior capstone course for the College of Business. One of his most cherished accomplishments was generating student interest in creating Team Red, which became the university's official student fan club of EWU Athletics.



Timothy J. Rolfe

Timothy J. Rolfe, BA, BS, MS, PhD, joined the Eastern Washington University Computer Science Department as a visiting associate professor in the fall of 1998. Mid-quarter of winter 2000, he was offered, and accepted, the position of tenure-track associate professor. In fall 2003, he was promoted to professor.

Rolfe earned his Bachelor of Arts degree in philosophy in 1965, from Mount Angel Seminary in Oregon. Military service in the U.S. Air Force gave him access to the GI Bill, which funded the Bachelor of Science degree from the University of Oregon in 1975, with majors in chemistry, computer science and mathematics, as well as a strong physics background.

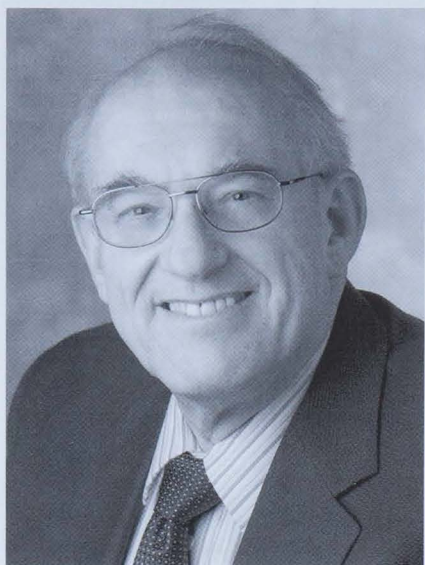
At the University of Chicago, where he earned his doctorate degree in 1982, Rolfe worked under Stuart Rice on molecular dynamical problems, producing as his thesis "Computer Studies of Molecular Vibrational Behavior."

Through Stuart Rice, Rolfe went to a post-doctoral position to bring up a VAX-11/780 computer system for the Chemistry Department at MIT, and while there, he interviewed for, and received, the offer of a position at Gonzaga University.

Based on the doctorate in a related field, Gonzaga hired Rolfe as an assistant professor of computer science in fall of 1983. He continued with Gonzaga for four years, but then returned to academia for formal graduate studies in computer science.

In December 1989, Rolfe received his Master of Science degree in computer science from the University of Minnesota, which was followed by a position as assistant professor of computer science at Dakota State University in Madison, S.D. Tenure and promotion to associate professor followed in 1995, and finally departure to Eastern Washington University after spring of 1998.

TRUSTEES' MEDAL AWARD



William T. "Tom" Trulove

William T. "Tom" Trulove, professor of economics, is the recipient of the 2011 Trustees' Medal Award.

Trulove began teaching economics at Eastern in 1969, and has served as chair of the department since 1996. He studied economics at the University of Oregon, where he received his doctorate degree in 1973, master's degree in 1968, and bachelor's degree in 1965.

Over the years, he has received many honors including, the Jeffers Chertok Dean's Honor Faculty Award in June 2006; Service Award, American Society of Engineers in 1996, and the EWU President's Medal in 1993.

Trulove's contributions can be found in all areas of his activities – in education, public service and involvement with the regional business community.

As a faculty member, he has successfully instructed students through the economics curriculum. The consistency of his superior evaluations, done anonymously by students each quarter, is evidence of his significant contributions to the university's instructional commitment. His teaching of economics, business development, public finance and natural resources, have been highly effective and closely coordinated with his external work with economic development in the region.

As chair of the Economics Department, Trulove has instilled a student-centered culture. This includes

making sure faculty are available for student advising and mentoring, and recruiting majors to work on faculty projects to give them hands-on experience. He has put an emphasis on preparing students for the job market by creating a more formalized internship process and reaching out to employers to assist in placement of students after graduation. He's also worked to raise private monies for several scholarships. Trulove has been a regular contributor to the field of economics, providing a steady stream of articles, chapters, cases and research reports. He has undertaken a number of research projects including the economic impact of Eastern Washington University; the crisis in Washington municipal finance; the impact of the aluminum industry in Eastern Washington; conversion of the local waste-to-energy plant to electricity generation; and the economics of regional solid waste collection and disposal. Results of some of these studies were later presented at regional and national conferences.

As a citizen, he has made a significant impact locally and regionally. Trulove is currently serving his second term as mayor of Cheney, (his first term was from 1978-1986) and is a former city council member. In those roles, he has pushed ahead with measures to improve the community. He serves on the Greater Spokane Incorporated Board of Trustees, and has previously served on the Spokane County Health Board and the Cheney Planning Commission.

On the state level, Trulove has served

The Trustees' Medal Award is the university's highest form of recognition for faculty achievement. Each year since 1978, the award has honored teaching excellence, significant contributions to scholarship and research, and accomplishments in the development of academic programs and curriculums. The award consists of a bronze medallion and a \$1,500 cash prize from the EWU Foundation.

as chair of the Community Economic Revitalization Board (CERB), appointed by former Gov. Gary Locke in 1999, and appointed chair by Gov. Chris Gregoire in 2005 and 2007. CERB is a major sponsor of millions of dollars worth of infrastructure development projects around the state. He also served as head of the Northwest Power Planning Council for former Gov. Booth Gardner.

Trulove has also worked with state and federal administrative agencies, leading a U.S. delegation on energy industry exchanges with the former Soviet Union and helping to organize a United Nations-sponsored international energy conference in Paris.

As an active member in the regional business community, he was instrumental in establishing the Institute for Public Policy and Economic Analysis, which has raised the regional profile of the university and the Department of Economics.

Trulove has consulted widely on economic development and has served on many boards of directors. He served as a member of the Associated Industries board of directors since 1995, and is currently the board chair. He also serves on the board of directors for Cheney Care Center and Cheney Care Foundation.

During his 41 years at Eastern, Trulove has amassed an extensive record of teaching, scholarly and service contributions, which benefit not only the university, but also the citizens of the state and the Inland Northwest.

DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARDS

The Distinguished Service Awards, one for a classified staff employee and one for an administrative exempt employee, are given each year to recognize exemplary service and outstanding contributions to the University. Letters of nomination and support are reviewed by the University

Medals and Awards Committee. The award includes the Distinguished Service Award medallion and a check for \$1,000. These awards were presented at the University Family Thanksgiving Dinner on Nov. 19, 2010.

Leslie Swannack provides administrative support to the Vice Provost for Graduate Education, Research, Academic Planning and Evaluation; to the Vice Provost for Academic Administration and to the Graduate Studies office.

Swannack began working at Eastern in March 2006. Prior to that, she worked as an instructional aide for St. John School District in St. John, Wash. She holds a BA in business administration from Washington State University.

In her role as administrative assistant, Swannack works to ensure that the day-to-day operations of several departments run smoothly and efficiently. The quality of her work is always at the highest level and her work ethic has made her indispensable to her colleagues.

"If there is an efficiency to be found under Leslie's control, she will find it and utilize it," wrote Kristi Duenas in Graduate Studies. "She has streamlined processes, learned new software, you name it — and she has done it, with a goal in mind of being more efficient and effective, while providing students with ever-better service and information."

During his term as interim Vice Provost, Dr. Anthony Flinn found Leslie's assistance invaluable. "If I did not make a royal bollocks of things, it was largely due to the relentlessly patient support of Leslie Swannack. Leslie always struck the perfect balance between taking the

initiative and taking special requests through the proper channels. Leslie's official demeanor is one of quiet and focus, but it veils only thinly a frisky sense of irony, which is both intelligent and generously good-humored. That combination encourages a comfortable and engaged office environment where good work can be done on schedule, in a state of high morale. After a 30-year career in both the private and the public sectors, I have rarely, if ever, encountered such cheerful and effective professionalism in administrative work as I have from Leslie Swannack these past six months."

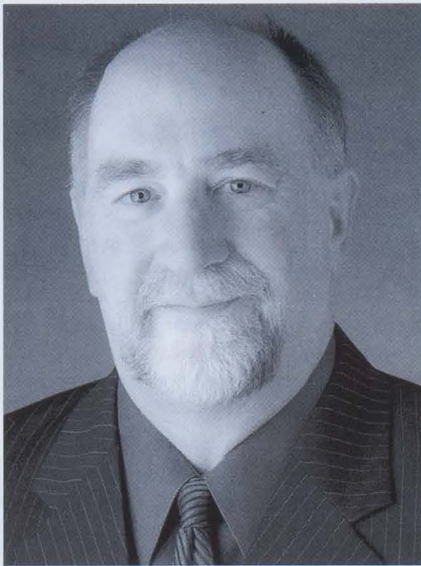

John Neace has made immeasurable contributions throughout his 27 years of service to the university. He has been instrumental in Eastern's outreach to adult learners since the early 1980s, and has supported and encouraged more than 2,000 students in the pursuit of their academic dreams.

Currently, Neace is the senior director of EWU's Division for International and Educational Outreach (DIEO). He is responsible for the oversight and development, administration and evaluation of online courses and programs. He provides oversight to Eastern's Interdisciplinary Studies Degree and all online, off-campus and self-support program development originating from DIEO.

Under his leadership, Eastern's online course enrollment has increased an average of 33 percent over the past two years.

Neace has been involved in positioning the five degree programs currently being offered at EWU at Bellevue College. "John has been instrumental in the development of the budgets and structure of the psychology program in Bellevue and the children's studies online degree," wrote Vickie Shields, dean of the College of Social and Behavioral Science and Social Work. "He has done an outstanding job in this position."

Sara Sexton-Johnson, program director of DIEO writes, "John gives of his time unreservedly and generously, providing direction, exper-

tise and assistance in achieving positive growth for the student and the university. Whenever I am in the community representing EWU, it never fails — one on John's former students shares with me how critical he was to their professional and personal growth."

One of those former students is Greg Bever, publisher of the Journal of Business. He earned his interdisciplinary studies degree in 1989. Bever wrote, "At 36 years old, as a returning adult learner, I joined the Interdisciplinary Studies Program taught by John Neace. His encouragement led to successes, which built confidence and finally created a burning desire to gain more knowledge. Mr. Neace continued his counsel and guidance until my degree was completed. It was the roadmap he provided and the confidence he instilled that made the difference and helped me find success."

One of Neace's program's success stories, Grace Creasman, is now the interim director of EWU's Addiction Studies Program. She summed up Neace's contribution, stating, "John does not look for recognition while he provides his services with some very long and hard days. He does what he does because that is the person he is. If there is a need, he is looking for a way to make it a reality. John provides services to faculty, staff, students and the administration because he appreciates a job well done and exemplifies that in his daily life."

2010-2011 FRANCES B. HUSTON MEDALLION AWARDS

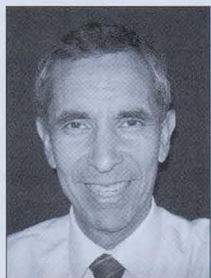

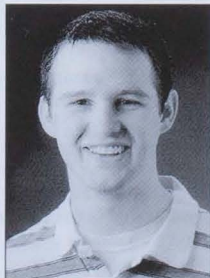
