STATE NORMAL SCHOOL

N. D. SHOWALTER, PRINCIPAL

CHENEY, WASHINGTON, Oct. 9, '14.

The Trustees of the State Normal School met at Hotel Spokane at 12:00 M. Those present Mrs. Monroe, Mr. McLean, Mr. Tustin, and Mr. Showalter.

The regular bills of the month were audited.

The Trustees discussed at some length a plan for improving the Normal School grounds, and Mr. Showalter was authorized to secure bids and contracts and have the buildings moved from the front campus.

The application of Mr. R. J. Clarke was read, and it was moved by Mr. McLean and seconded by Mr. Tustin that Mr. Clarke be employed at \$200.00 per month to make the necessary survey and plan the grounds properly. The salary in this case is to be based on the regular monthly basis of 30 days and is to be paid for time actually rendered. The Trustees authorized the work to be conducted under the direction of Mr. McLean and Mr. Showalter.

Mr. Showalter was authorized to rent a piano for the Piano Department with the provision that in case the instrument is purchased later the rental paid is to be applied on the price.

Meeting adjourned at 1:40 P. M.
