Spokane, Washington, Jan. 7, '15.

A Meeting of the Board of Trustees was held at Spokane, Washington, at 12 o'clock M. Those present: Mrs. Monroe, Chairman, Mr. Tustin, Mr. McLean, Mr. Zittel and Mr. Showalter.

A verbal report was given to the Trustees by the Architect, Mr. Zittel, who stated that the work was progressing much more rapidly and that he was urging the Contractor, Mr. Huetter to carry forward the work with all possible speed. He stated that Mr. Vantyne had been requested to give him daily reports relating to the progress of the work, and that every means would be used to have it finished at the earliest possible date.

The Trustees insisted upon the work being finished before April 1st because at that date all moneys appropriated by the last Legislature will revert to the state.

A telegram, which was sent by Auditor Clausen to Mr. H. N. Stronach, was read to the Board of Trustees and upon a motion passed unanimously the Trustees expressed their willingness to assist in every way in furnishing the desired information, and instructed Mr. Zittel to get out copies of the material under his immediate supervision, just as soon as possible.

The Trustees discussed briefly fixtures and furniture, but no definite action was taken.

Meeting adjourned at 2:00 P.M.
