MEET THE COACHES

Western Washington

Charles Lappenbusch, dean of the state's football coaches, is in his 21st year as head coach of Viking football. After finishing sixth in the loop's first year of play, his teams have been in the top three since, finishing in a three-way tie for the championship in 1951. Lappenbusch played for College of Puget Sound and the University of Washington and was an assistant to Jimmy Phelan at Washington before going to Western. He is nationally known for his straight-line philosophy of football. Lappenbusch also is athletic director and head tennis coach.

Assistants are Ray Ciszek, who is in his seventh year at Western, and Vic Lee, formerly a star back for the Vikings. Ciszek, who played for the University of Illinois, also is track coach.

College of Puget Sound

John Heinrick, in his sixth year at College of Puget Sound, has a record of 28 wins, 10 losses and five ties. His Loggers have shared in three Evergreen titles and never have finished lower than fourth. Heinrick played for Central Washington and was graduated from the University of Washington. Heinrick, a successful high-school coach in Tacoma before going to C. P. S., also is athletic director and basketball coach.

Joe Hemel, a Washington State College grad, and Wally Erwin, who finished out a three-sport career for the Loggers last season. Hemel, a native of Tacoma, assisted at W. S. C. and coached high-school football before joining the C. P. S. staff. Hemel also is baseball coach and assists in basketball.

Central Washington

L. G. (Clipper) Carmody, is opening his fourth year as coach at his alma mater. Carmody, a star for the Wildcats as a player, saw his team finish seventh his first year, brought them to fourth in 1951 and fifth last season.

Del Peterson, who came to Central with Carmody, and Bill Repenshek, who finished his playing days for Central last season, are assistants.

Meet the coaches (con't.)

Pacific Lutheran

Mary Harshman, pass-catching wizard of one of the Northwest's greatest forward-passing combinations, opens his third year as head coach of his alma mater bidding for his third Evergreen title. His Lutes won the title outright last season after finishing in a tie for the lead in 1951. Harshman also is athletic director, basketball and baseball coach.

Mark Salzman, a Carthage College graduate, is assisting Harshman for the third year. Salzman is track coach and assistant basketball mentor. Ramon L. Barnes and Oliver C. Magnuson, line stalwarts of the championship elevens, and Arthur E. Swanson, former backfield ace, also are helping out.

Whitworth

Jim Lounsberry, who directed Whitworth to third place last season, the highest the school ever has finished in the grid standings, is a graduate of Central Washington. Before going to the Spokane school he was a high-school coach and freshman line coach at the University of Washington. Lounsberry also also coaches track and is athletic director.

Art Smith, new basketball coach at Whitworth, was a three-sport star at Alma College, was a backfield coaching aide at Idaho. Bill Van Camp, an outstanding lineman at Whitworth, is assisting in training the forward wall.

Eastern Washington

Ed Chissus, a former star at Eastern Washington, returns to the school as head coach. During his high-school coaching career, Ed's teams won 53 games while losing 27.

Another Eastern grad with high-school experience is Bill Nye, who will serve as assistant.

University of British Columbia

Don Coryell, former University of Washington backfield star, returns to the Northwest this year as head coach of the University of British Columbia. He coached for two years in Honolulu and also played for the Hawaiian All-Stars in the annual Hula Bowl game.

Dick Mitchell, in his third year as U. B. C. aide, is a graduate of the Canadian school. Before returning to the Thunderbird school, he was an assistant coach at the University of Toronto. He also is hockey coach.
