A Meeting of the Board of Trustees was called to meet at 12 o'clock at Hotel Spokane. Those present Mrs. Monroe, Chairman, Mr. Tustin, Mr. MacLean, and Mr. Showalter.


The progress of the work on the school grounds was discussed at some length, Mr. Showalter giving a brief report of the conditions.


The resignation of Mr. Henry was presented to the Board of Trustees and accepted. Mr. Showalter also presented the situation concerning the change of work which would take place in connection with the co-operation of the High School, and it was thought best under the circumstances to discontinue the work of the 9th and 10th grades which Miss Campbell is now doing. Under these circumstances Miss Campbell would not be needed, and Mr. Showalter was requested to give the proper information to both Miss Campbell and Mr. Henry.

The program for dedication was considered at some length. It was agreed that the same plan should be followed as was considered earlier. The first program of the day will be held at 10:00 o'clock, the second at 2:30, and the final program will be held at 8:00 o'clock followed by a general reception.

Mr. Showalter was authorized to secure the services if possible of Dr. David Starr Jordan and to spend as much as \$350.00, if necessary, in order to meet the expense. It was agreed that in case Mr. Jordan could not be procured, the matter should be taken up with other speakers of like character to be again referred to the Board of Trustees if necessary.

Meeting adjourned at 2:00 o'clock.
