Dr. George W. Lotzenhiser, Director of the Division of Creative Arts at Eastern Washington State College, is the Winter Quarter Commencement Speaker.

Dr. Lotzenhiser received his Bachelor's Degree from Eastern Washington State College where, as an undergraduate, he was President of the Associated Student Body. He received his Master's Degree from the University of Oregon.

Among his professional accomplishments is the composition of more than twenty musical selections, Associate Conductor of the Tucson Symphony Orchestra, and President of the Eastern Washington Music Educator's Association. He is listed in Who's Who in Music, Who's Who in the West, and Who's Who in American Education. Dr. Lotzenhiser returned to Eastern Washington State College in 1960 as Director of the Division of Creative Arts.
