Dr. Don S. Patterson, the 16th chief administrator in the 76 year history of Eastern Washington State College, was appointed president August 1954 and will retire in August 1967.

In 1963, Dr. Patterson was one of six college presidents selected as representatives of the American Association of Colleges for Teacher Education for a State Department study of teacher training purposes in Poland.

Dr. Patterson has served Education in the State of Washington and throughout the United States. For instance, from 1947 until 1954 he served in the Federal Office of Education, Washington, D.C., where he was chief of the elementary division. He is also a member of the Higher Education Facilities Commission; is on the board of trustees of the Spokane Community Action Council; is a member of the Council of the Federation of Regional Accrediting Commissions of Higher Education; is a member of the Inland Empire Boy Scout board, the Spokane Council of Churches and a member of the National Probation and Parole Board.

"EDUCATION IN A CHANGING WORLD" is the title of his Commencement address.
