A Meeting of the Board of Trustees met at the Davenport Hotel on May 11th at 12:00 M. Those present were Mrs. Mary A Monroe, Chairman, Mr. MacLean, Mr. Tustin, and Mr. Showalter.

Mr. Showalter presented a request made by Mr. Geo. E. Craig of the Rural School Department for a leave of absence during the summer months in order to attend Teachers' College, Columbia. The request was granted and the Trustees authorized Mr. Showalter and Mrs. Monroe to secure someone for the work during Summer School.

Mr. W. G. Whitford was chosen Superintendent of the Training School at a salary of \$2,000 per year----- services to begin Sept. 1st, 1916.

Miss Eulalia Wylie was chosen to assist in the Music Department during the Summer Session at a salary of \$225 for the nine weeks' session.

The Board of Trustees discussed the situation caused by a lack of settlement between Mr. Heutter and Mr. Quaring. It was decided to look into the matter to see what influence the Board might exert in bringing about a settlement.
