
The Board of Trustees was called to meet at 12:15 P.M. at Pavenport Hotel. Those present, Mrs. Monroe, Chairman, Mr. Tustin, Mr. McLean, and Mr. Showalter.


Mr. Showalter reported the completion of the heating plant by the contractors, Pratt and Watson. The Board of Trustees decided to request the Architect, Mr. Julius A. Zittel to inspect the work and give to them a final report before the last payment was made.

Mr. Showalter again called the attention of the Board of Trustees to some conditions investigated concerning Mr. Prouty's work in connection with the heating plant and also gave a statement of a report which came to him concerning Mr. Prouty's use of the state water system in connection with his own private lawn. It was fully explained that this statement was made on the report of two individuals who had called the matter to Mr. Showalter's attention. The Board authorized an investigation of the conditions and decided to hold a special meeting at Cheney on Saturday, November 24th, for the purpose of determining what definite action should be taken concerning the matter.

The two reports of the inspecting engineer, Mr. S. F. Roberts, were read by the Trustees and discussed at some length.
