June 27, '18.

A meeting of the Board of Trustees was called to meet at Davenport Hotel at 12:30 P.M. Those present Mrs. Monroe, Mr. Tustin, Mr. McLean and Mr. Showalter.

Mr. Showalter reported the general status of the progress made in connection with the Rolfe Property and the Board of Trustees authorized Mrs. Monroe to sign the contract for the Board when the same shall have been approved by the Attorney General. The amount agreed upon for the property is \$2,500, the same to be paid in accordance with the contract drawn and approved by Mr. Tustin.
