Board of Trustees Minutes, September 22, 1919

Cheney Normal School

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September 22 - 1919

A meeting of the Board of Trustees was called to meet at Davenport Hotel at Twelve O'clock M. Those present Mrs. Monroe, Chairman, Mr. Tustin, and Mr. Showalter.

The letter concerning changes in the heating valve from I. J. Blair, Contractor, to Architect Julius A Zittel was presented to the Board of Trustees. Since there would be a considerable saving by making the change, the recommendation of the Architect was approved by the Trustees.

A letter from Mr. Fred Phair, General Contractor, was also presented to the Board of Trustees. Mr. Phair requested twenty-five days extension of time on the contract on account of the delay caused by failure to get the buildings moved in time. This request was granted by the Board of Trustees.

The regular monthly vouchers were presented and audited.

Mr. Showalter reported the new teachers secured for the Training School Department on account of resignations and leave of absence. This matter was approved by the Trustees.

Mr. Showalter reported improvement on the building and on the grounds including street work.

Plans were arranged to have a meeting in Cheney on Thursday Evening, September Twenty-five.
