
A meeting of the Board of Trustees was called to meet at 12:15 P. M. at Davenport Hotel. Those present Mrs. Mary A. Monroe, Chairman, Mr. Tustin and Mr. Showalter.

Mr. Showalter gave a report of the special session of the Legislature and explained the action taken in connection with the Institution. The report mentioned the fact that it was agreed at the Special Session that the institutions of this state be permitted to use the money appropriated for the biennium during the first twenty-one months, and that special appropriation be made after January 1st, 1921, to take care of the remainder of the biennial budget.


The recommendation of the Governor was brought to the attention of the Board of Trustees, and the fact that the general state levy was changed from three to five mills for the purpose of raising the additional amount of money necessary to finance state institutions.

The Trustees examined the recommendations made for the general salary schedule and gave only a tentative approval with the understanding that the whole matter be withheld until Mr. McLean could meet with them so that his judgment might be had before final approval was given. Mr. Showalter was authorized to write Mr. McLean and send him the proposed schedule of salaries and ask his suggestions or approval.
