Meeting of Board of Trustees was held on above date at Davenport's at five o'clock p. m. Those present Mrs. Mary A. Monroe, Chairman, Mr. Lund, Senator Myers, and Mr. Showalter.

The President gave a report on the information and quotations received for sterilization of the water used at the Institution. The Trustees asked that definite propositions be requested from each of the firms quoted and the same submitted to them for consideration at the next regular meeting.

The President requested a joint meeting of the Trustees with the local directors of the public schools at Cheney. He explained the need for such a meeting and made a report on a former meeting of the local school directors which he had been requested to attend.

It was further explained that the Training School at Cheney shows greater cost to the State than the training schools at either of the other institutions (normal schools) because of the fact that all of the public school revenues had been claimed by District No. 20. At each of the other state normals in the state, considerable financial assistance has been given by the respective public schools.




