Meeting of Board of Trustees called at 11:40 a. m. on above date at Davenport Hotel. Those present Mrs. Mary A. Monroe, Chairman, Mr. Lund, Mr. Myers, and Mr. Showalter.

A report from Mr. Stronach was presented showing a comparative statement of funds for last year and for the new year beginning April 1st, 1924.

The President was authorized to secure such summer school instructors as proved to be necessary to care for the work of the summer quarter properly.

Upon recommendation of the President, Mr. Albert Ray Lang was chosen head of the Department of Education at a salary of four thousand dollars per year - - work to begin September 4th.

Mr. O. W. Freeman was elected to the Department of Science and Mathematics at a salary of three thousand dollars per year - - work to begin September 1st.

The following adjustments were made in salary of regular faculty members to begin September, 1924.

Mr. E. L. Dales, twenty-eight hundred dollars.

Miss Vivian Turner, twenty-seven hundred dollars.

Mr. J. Orin Oliphant, twenty-eight hundred dollars.

Miss Mary E. Barton, eighteen hundred dollars.

The Trustees approved the purchase of cold storage equipment to be purchased from Armstrong Machinery Company, Spokane.

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The President presented a plan for a campus picture board to be placed at the intersection of the Lincoln and Normal Highway by the Commercial Club of Cheney. After some discussion, the Trustees decided that there could be no objection to such a picture board providing it was properly placed and painted in a manner to meet the full approval of the President.

The President was authorized to confer with Mr. Hungate, of the Department of Applied Science and Arts, and secure a teacher for the next school year, beginning September 1st, to take the place of Miss Hazel Plympton, who has been granted a leave of absence for study in New York.
