BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING

The Board of Trustees met at the Davenport Hotel at 12:15 P.M., Friday, July 22, 1932. Present: Mr. Lund, Mrs. Fancy, and Mr. Hargreaves.

LEAVES OF ABSENCE: Mr. Hargreaves presented the following requests for leaves of absence for the fall quarter: Mr. Kingston, Miss Dustin, Dr. Freeman, Miss Swerer, and Miss Hollingshead.

The Board decided that the school would grant leaves of absence this year only where the work could be carried without additional expense to the school.


The request of Mr. Dayton for nine months' leave (with one quarter on pay) was taken up as a special case and granted with the understanding that Mr. Hargreaves should secure people from Spokane to fill Mr. and Mrs. Dayton's places and that these substitutes should be paid entirely out of the fees.

Dr. Freeman's request was denied because he assumed the extension work last fall, and the Board felt that he had been quite generously dealt with in the matter of leaves of absence.

SUMMER SCHOOL COMMENCEMENT: Mr. Hargreaves reported that the matter of the summer school commencement had been taken up with the class early in the year by Mr. Buchanan, the summer school director, and it had been decided to do away with formal graduation exercises.

AUDITORS: Mr. Hargreaves reported that Mr. R. P. Fraser had told him that the auditors would be through with their work at the school and leave on Friday, July 29.
