MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The Board of Trustees met at the Davenport Hotel at twelve o'clock noon, Thursday, July 5, 1934. Present: Mr. Richard S. Munter, Mr. James P. Dillard, Mr. Joel E. Ferris, Mr. R. T. Hargreaves and Mr. H. N. Stronach.

HEATING PLANT: It has become necessary that a new pressure tank be installed at the heating plant to take the place of the present one, which has been reported defective by the Hartford Boiler Insurance Inspector.

The old boiler has been in service over twenty years and is now in such condition that it may break down at any-time. The estimated cost of a new boiler will be about \$800.00. As this is an emergency, the Board authorized Mr. Stronach to have prepared specifications for this boiler and to ask for bids from Spokane firms engaged in this line.

TUNNEL: Mr. Hargreaves and Mr. Stronach presented a preliminary report on the proposed tunnel system. Mr. Ralph Nelson, heating engineer of Spokane, after looking over the campus buildings and grounds, gave a preliminary estimate of the cost of constructing tunnels and installing heating lines at \$18,000. The Board will consider a more detailed report at a later meeting.

The meeting adjourned at 1:30 P.M.
