MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The Board of Trustees met in the Davenport Hotel for luncheon at 12:15 P. M., Friday, June 15th, 1935. Present: Richard S. Munter; Joel E. Ferris; James P. Dillard; H. N. Stronach and R. T. Hargreaves.

BUILDING: Application for federal grant and aid for new training school building and equipment was submitted for consideration and approval. A Summary of this application shows:

The architects, George M. Rasque and Charles I. Carpenter also met with the Board for consultation.


HEATING LINE: The following resolution was moved by Mr. Dillard and seconded by Mr. Ferris and unanimously carried:

"Be it resolved by the Board of Trustees of the State Normal School, Cheney, Washington

Section 1. That R. T. Hargreaves, be and he is authorized to execute and file an application on behalf of the State Normal School, Cheney, Washington, to the United States of America for a grant to aid in financing the construction of an underground heating line conduit system.

Section 2. That R. T. Hargreaves, is hereby authorized and directed to furnish such information as the United States of America through the Federal Emergency Administration of Public Works may reasonably request in connection with the application which is herein authorized to be filed."

The meeting adjourned at 1:15 P. M.
