MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The Board of Trustees met in the Davenport Hotel for luncheon at 12:15 P. M., Saturday, June 29th, 1935. Present: Richard S. Munter; Joel E. Ferris; James P. Dillard; H. N. Stronach and R. T. Hargreaves.


HEATING LINE: Mr. Hargreaves recommended that the architects, George M. Rasque and Charles I. Carpenter be appointed to prepare the plans and to supervise the construction of the conduit system. The recommendation was unanimously approved.

TRAINING SCHOOL: Mr. Hargreaves reported on the conference that he and Mr. Stronach and the representatives of the other Normal Schools had with Governor Martin in his office at one-thirty, June 18th. The Governor made it clear that in any amplification for a building project at any of these institutions, the over-all cost, including Federal Grants, shouldn't exceed the amount appropriated by the legislature. We, however, drew the inference that the Governor regarded this as an approximation to be kept in mind rather than an absolute figure, since he entered no objection to Cheney's request for \$270,000 which over-runs the appropriation figure of \$250,000.
