


BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING

The Board of Trustees of the Eastern Washington College of Education met for luncheon at the Davenport Hotel, Friday, January 14, 1938. Present: Richard S. Munter, Joel E. Ferris, James P. Dillard, and R. T. Hargreaves.

PROPERTY: Mr. Hargreaves reported that payment had been made for the Tyler property, Lots 6, 7, and 8, Block 108, the Addition to Town of Cheney, Spokane County, Washington and the deed filed. Also, payment had been made to Mrs. M. W. Conway for her property lots 1 and 2, Block 4, Town of Cheney.

LIBRARY: After luncheon the Board adjourned to Mr. Rasque's office, architect for the new library, to view some drawings and clear up some points. They approved the plan to put three doors instead of two in the main entrance and suggested that Mr. Rasque excavate the entire basement and install an automatic pump and sump to take care of the water problem.
