BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING

The Board of Trustees of the Eastern Washington College of Education met at the Davenport Hotel, Wednesday, November 8, 1939, at 6:30. Present: Richard S. Munter, Joel E. Ferris, James P. Dillard, and Ralph E. Tieje.

LANDSCAPING AND REPLANTING ON CAMPUS: Mr. S. J. Walsh, of the State Department of Highways, presented the plans for landscaping and replanting on the campus. These plans included a large master-plan and separate large scale plans for each building.

No action was taken, but it was agreed: (1) that Mr. J. S. Lane, Superintendent of Buildings and Grounds, should proceed with such replantings and removings as did not require expert help and could be carried out with student labor and funds available for it; (2) that Mr. Walsh be requested to explain the plans to Governor Martin; (3) that Judge Dillard should consult the Governor as to the availability of present or future funds for this work.

The meeting adjourned at 9:15.
