February 14, 1947

The Board of Trustees of the Eastern Washington College of Education met in the office of George M. Rasque, Architect, Spokane, Washington at 4:00 p.m. on Friday, February 14, 1947. Present: Mr. Dave S. Cohn, acting Chairman, Mrs. Leslie Barber, member, Mr. George M. Rasque, Architect, and W. W. Isle, President.

The first order of business, minutes of the meeting held on January 21, 1947 were read and approved.


Bids were opened on the moving and re-erecting of the Drill Hall Building from the Farragut Naval Base to the campus of Eastern Washington College of Education. The following bids were received:


Carson Construction Company, \$336,647, Alternate No. 1 \$4,087,  
Alternate No. 2 \$6,152.

Gaasland Construction Company, \$306,900, Alternate No. 1 \$5,160,  
Alternate No. 2 \$4,400.

The Board voted to accept the low bid which was submitted by the Gaasland Construction Company in the amount of \$306,900.00. The Board directed the President to notify the Gaasland Construction Company that their bid has been accepted and that contract will be executed, if and when a satisfactory arrangement is worked out between the Gaasland Construction Company and the Federal Works Agency for the dismantling of the building.

There being no further business, the Board adjourned.
