Dr. John Cody Birdwell
Guest Conductor & Clinician



Dr. John Cody Birdwell is Director of Bands at the University of Kentucky, where his duties include conducting the University of Kentucky Wind Symphony, directing graduate programs in wind-band conducting, teaching graduate courses in instrumental conducting, history and literature, and supervising the administration of the University of Kentucky band program in the School of Music. Prior to his appointment at the University of Kentucky, Dr. Birdwell served as Director of Bands at Texas Tech University, Director of Bands at Utah State University, Assistant Director of Bands at the University of Illinois, and Director of Bands at Northern Michigan University.

Dr. Birdwell and the University of Kentucky Bands will serve as hosts for the 2017 National Convention of the American Bandmasters Association, March 8-11, in Lexington, Kentucky, and the UK Wind Symphony will be featured as a performing ensemble during the ABA convention. Dr. Birdwell's ensembles have toured extensively throughout the United States, China, and Great Britain, and the University of Kentucky Wind Symphony was recently selected to perform at the 2013 National Convention of the College Band Directors National Association. Ensembles under Dr. Birdwell's direction have also performed at numerous CBDNA national and division Conferences, and have also performed for the Kentucky Music Educator's Association, Texas Music Educators Convention, Texas Bandmaster's Association Convention, and the Utah Music Educators Association. In 2008 the UK Wind Symphony toured the People's Republic of China, and performed to capacity audiences in the cities of Suzhou, Yangzhou, Changzhou, and Beijing.

Birdwell has collaborated with and premiered works by a variety of celebrated artists, conductors, and composers including Joe Alessi, Allen Vizutti, Arturo Sandoval, Michael Colgrass, Bob Mintzer, David Maslanka, Luis Serrano Alarcon, Tim Reynish, Frederick Fennell, Paul Dooley, Dan Welcher, Donald Grantham, John Mackey, Anthony Barfield, Mike Mower, and Adam Gorb. Several compact discs, including the University of Kentucky Wind Ensemble "Distilled in Kentucky – Premieres from the Bluegrass State", and "GO! – The Music of Bob Mintzer", along with the Texas Tech University Symphonic Wind Ensemble "LIVE!" and "Diversions" have received acclaim from composers and conductors throughout the United States, Europe, and Asia.

Dr. Birdwell is an elected member of the prestigious American Bandmasters Association and holds degrees from The University of North Texas and West Texas A&M University.

Dr. Birdwell serves as President of the College Band Directors National Association Southern Division, and holds memberships in the College Band Directors National Association, National Band Association, Kentucky Music Educators Association, National Association for Music Education, Phi Beta Mu, Michigan School Band and Orchestra Association, Kappa Kappa Psi and Phi Mu Alpha. He remains active as a guest conductor, clinician and adjudicator throughout the United States and abroad.

Dr. Donald Goodwin



Don Goodwin recently completed his Doctorate of Musical Arts from the University of Kentucky in the area of Band Conducting. A graduate of Eastern Washington University where he received his Master of Arts in Composition (2007), Goodwin currently serves as Director of Bands at EWU.

In addition, Goodwin teaches or has taught Marching Band, Symphonic Band, music theory, counterpoint, jazz small groups, jazz piano, and currently supervises EWU's premiere athletic pep band, Code Red.

As of May, 2015, Don is now the new musical director of the Spokane Jazz Orchestra. In addition, Don is the pianist for The Bob Curnow Big Band, and plays in several area groups as a sideman. Don was featured as a soloist on Curnow's most recent album, "The

Music of Metheny and Mays II."

Don has had several of his original big band charts published by eJazzlines, and recently began publishing band music through Gary P. Gilroy Publications.

Bands At Eastern

The Eastern Washington University Band Program provides a wide variety of exciting musical opportunities for all university students, regardless of their major field of study. About two-thirds of the students who make up Eastern's bands are music majors, but many non-majors find it a rewarding and challenging experience to participate in any of our many bands. These groups include: Wind Ensemble, Symphonic Band, Marching Band, Jazz Ensemble, Jazz Repertory Ensemble, Jazz Lab Band, Jazz Small Groups and Code Red (Pep Band).

Over the years, many guest artists have appeared on campus including Allen Vizzutti, Craig Kirchhoff, Eugene Corporan, Robert Ponto, Gunther Schuller, Libby Larsen, Tom Staples, Mike Boschen, and Thomas Lee. EWU bands have performed Washington Music Educators Association conferences, All-Northwest M.E.N.C. conferences, Festival Nelson British Columbia, Monterey Jazz Festival, the CBDNA Regional Conference (Reno, NV), and the Collegiate Wind Festival at California State University, Fresno. The Wind Ensemble can be heard on their two compact discs entitled CELEBRATIONS and DANCES, SONGS & CELEBRATIONS as well as the EWU Music Department's three CD's, SOUNDSCAPES, PRISMS, and MILLENIUM.

In Addition to these ensembles, there are many other performing groups at Eastern. These include Flute Choir, Saxophone Quartets, Brass Quintets, Trombone Choir, Tuba/Euphonium Ensemble, Percussion Ensemble, Symphony Orchestra, String Quartets, Concert Choir, Symphonic Choir, two Vocal Jazz Ensembles, Contemporary Ensemble, and Opera.
