Wyatt Wireman is in his 4th year as a double bass performance major at Eastern Washington University. He is currently studying under Kim Plewniak and Josh Skinner, with study under other teachers including Scott Steed, Patrick McNally, David Allen Moore, Jordan Anderson, Travis Gore, and Jeff Bradetich. Wyatt is a substitute member in multiple orchestras and other ensembles across Eastern Washington and Northern Idaho. He is a native of Richland, and graduated from Richland High School in 2014. Wyatt will be attending The Cleveland Institute of Music in the fall of 2018 to pursue a Masters Degree in Double Bass Performance with Scott Dixon and Derek Zadinsky of The Cleveland Orchestra.
