**Dr. Timothy Robblee**  
**Guest Conductor & Clinician**



Tim Robblee is the Director of Bands and Associate Professor of Conducting at Shenandoah Conservatory where he where he guides all aspects of the wind band program, teaches conducting, and conducts the Wind Ensemble and EDGE Ensemble. Prior to his current appointment, he served as the Associate Director of Bands at Northwestern University where he was also music director and conductor of the Contemporary Music Ensemble. Previously, Robblee has also served as Director of Bands at Washington State University in Pullman, WA and Willamette University in Salem, OR.

Dr. Robblee holds a Ph.D. in wind band conducting and music education from the University of Minnesota, an MM in conducting from Northwestern University, and a BA in music education from Whitworth College in Spokane, WA. He also spent a year at the Munich Hochschule für Musik pursuing graduate clarinet studies. Prior to graduate study, he taught for eight years as an instrumental music educator in the Palo Alto, California public schools where his students and ensembles were recognized for excellence on a state and national level.

Dr. Robblee maintains an active schedule as a guest conductor in the United States, Canada, Asia, and Europe. Among his most recent engagements were the AMIS International Band hosted in Luxembourg, the Asia-Pacific Activities Conference Honor Band in Hong Kong, US Department of Defense All-Europe Honor Band, Korean International Music Educators Association National Honor Band, and honor bands across North America. As an advocate of music in the public schools, he has presented at music education conferences throughout North America and adjudicated at numerous music festivals. Robblee maintains active memberships in the College Band Directors National Association, Music Educators National Conference, Virginia Music Educators Association, and World Association for Symphonic Bands and Ensemble.

## **Dr. Donald Goodwin**



Dr. Don Goodwin leads an active life in music as a teacher, composer/arranger and performer. As a music educator, Dr. Goodwin has enjoyed teaching at Eastern Washington University for the past eleven years, where he is currently the director of bands. Goodwin's award-winning arrangements and compositions have been performed and recorded by high schools, colleges, and professional organizations around the country, and his music has been published with Gary Gilroy Music Publications, Walrus Music Publishing, and ejazzlines. Dr. Goodwin's performance career as a professional pianist and musical director includes extended engagements with The Bob Curnow Big Band, The Tom Molter Big Band, and while in Seattle, Goodwin was a member of the popular funk/rock/jazz groups BeeCraft, Flowmotion, and LaPush, with whom he toured around the country. He has recorded dozens of albums with those and other professional groups, including Curnow's most recent release which features arrangements of the music of Pat Metheny and Lyle Mays.

In May of 2015, Dr. Goodwin was selected as Music Director for the Spokane Jazz Orchestra. He holds a Bachelor of Music Education and a Master in Composition from Eastern Washington University, and completed his Doctorate of Musical Arts in band conducting from the University of Kentucky.

## **Dr. Joshua Lindberg, Southridge High School**

Joshua Lindberg is an upcoming music educator and performer. He earned his Doctor of Education from Concordia University Chicago. Prior to that, he earned a Master of Music degree in Conducting from Eastern Washington University under Dr. Don Goodwin. He is also a recognized National Certified Teacher of Music (NCTM) through Music Teachers National Association (MTNA). His undergraduate studies were with Dr. Jody Graves at EWU as well.

As a music education advocate, his research and dissertation focused around music teacher preparation. His dissertation was entitled "Am I Ready: How High School Instrumental Music Teachers Perceive Their Undergraduate Degree Prepared Them For Their Professional Career".

Currently, Dr. Lindberg is the Director of Bands and Orchestra at Southridge High School in Kennewick, WA where he teaches all the band, orchestra, and piano classes. He and his wife Lisa enjoy baking Gluten-Free treats, running with their dog Gus, and sipping on a great cup of coffee.

Heidi Hanes is in her 10<sup>th</sup> year teaching and 1<sup>st</sup> year as the band director at Lewis & Clark High School in Spokane, WA. A percussionist, Heidi earned a Bachelor's degree in Music Education from Eastern Washington University in 2011 and a Master's Degree in Band Conducting from Sam Houston State University in 2019.

Heidi began her teaching career in the Pasco School District in 2012 piloting the first ever World Drumming program in the district at McLoughlin Middle school serving approximately 600 students in one calendar year. From 2013-2021 Heidi was the director of bands at Pasco High School whose ensembles earned many successes and awards throughout the northwest in all areas including concert band, jazz, percussion, and marching band. Ensembles under Heidi's direction have been featured performing groups at the WMEA State Conference in 2017 and 2019. Heidi is also a regular adjudicator for large group band festivals and solo & ensemble contests throughout the state of Washington and has presented sessions at the WMEA State conference in 2021 and will present in February 2022.

Outside of band and percussion Heidi spends time with her husband Dave and their two German Shepherds, Melvin and Ziva. Heidi is also a huge Mariners baseball fan, distance runner, amateur baker, and is an "Office" trivia extraordinaire.
